These councils advise me regarding the financial decisions of the parish. I truly value the time they give in service to our parish, as well as their expertise and wisdom. Should you have any questions regarding our parish finances, please feel free to bring them to me personally and I will address your concerns to the best of my ability.

As soon as I started my tenure as your pastor, I knew that publishing this financial report would be a high priority for several reasons. It will help you to take note of our financial health, it reflects where we place our priorities as a parish and it assures you that your contributions are being utilized in an effective way.
