Financial decisions about our two churches rest on my shoulders, as the pastor. At the same time, there are limits on my administration and supervisions called for by canon law and our archdiocesan policies. In addition to these, our parish is blessed to have a very capable finance council. In fact, both St. Patrick's and St. John the Baptist have their own finance councils that currently meet monthly. These councils advise me regarding the financial decisions of the parish. I truly value the time they give in service to our parish, as well as their expertise and wisdom. Should you have any questions regarding our parish finances, please feel free to bring them to me personally and I will address your concerns to the best of my ability.

As soon as I started my tenure as your pastor, I knew that publishing this financial report would be a high priority for several reasons. It will help you to take note of our financial health, it reflects where we place our priorities as a parish and it assures you that your contributions are being utilized in an effective way. All of us who call St. Patrick's our spiritual home know that our parish is a place truly worthy of our investment. I hope that this financial statement will serve to assure you that entrusting your time and money to St. Patrick's will advance the Kingdom of God.

I am very excited to support the **rosary initiative** of our parishioner, Mary Ramirez. She is looking for volunteers who will commit to saying a rosary for the priests who serve our parish and for other special intentions like the repose of the souls in Purgatory. This initiative does not have regular meetings, but encourages prayer at home throughout the week so that God's guidance and protection can accompany our clergy. I am humbled and grateful for Mrs. Ramirez's leadership in this program. Our goal is to have one person committed to praying for these intentions each day. In keeping with tradition, next week, August 25th, at the 11:00 a.m. Mass, St. Patrick's will welcome the **Ladies Ancient Order of Hibernians for the presentation of the Golden Rose.**
