A very special thank you to **Mr. Mike Hansen** for his assistance with some water damage repair projects in the rectory. His expertise and generosity are a true blessing!

If you've made a visit to Reynold's Hall you will notice how fresh and clean it is. This is thanks to **Mrs. Kimberly Kraus and her mother, XXXXX**. They completed the project over two weekends and their hard work has really paid off.

Not a soul enters St. Patrick's without noticing the sublime stained glass fan vault over the altar. We are in the process of **upgrading the lighting** so that the beauty of this glass is never diminished, day or night. Thanks to God, and our maintenance supervisor, Manolito, the upgrade is very affordable! Surplus donations for our narthex bench and façade sign projects will be applied to this upgrade.

Along with some zealous parishioners, I am excited to host another open house on **"White Linen Night,"** which is Saturday, August 3. As crowds pass on the street, we will be offering tours of the church and fellowship with refreshments in Reynolds Hall. These efforts are aimed at evangelization.
