SERVITE DOMINO IN TIMORE

A few weeks ago, in the annual financial report that I published, I mentioned that we will be replacing our air conditioning system in the coming year. I'm glad to say that we now have approval from the Archdiocese and a concrete plan to move forward with that work. First, a reminder of why we need the new system. Our current system was installed in the late 1980's and has suffered from a gradual decline in its efficiency. Some of the components have permanent flaws which cannot be fixed due to the loss of integrity over time. The external components are rusted and some are held together with zip-ties. Such deterioration is a real safety hazard to those who use our parish courtyard. The 5 independent units that cool our church are regulated individually and are not easily adjusted to maintain a consistent temperature. Most noticeably, the system is no longer capable of maintaining a comfortable temperature for our Sunday morning Mass schedule. This is complicated by our historic building which "leaks" cool air through walls, floors and doors. Finally, the current system cannot address the moisture issue which is causing the dark discoloration to the upper portions of the organ case. This discoloration is caused by poor circulation at upper levels, inadequate dehumidification and "overcooling." Overcooling is a phenomenon that occurs when, in order to overcompensate for the larger Sunday crowds, the interior temperature is lowered more than normal, even into the upper 60's. With an interior temperature that low, the influx of warm air that comes when parishioners arrive more easily condensates on hard surfaces. Such condensation leaves our organ and ceiling prone to discoloration. Even the interior of the organ itself has been effected by this problem.

For all of these reasons Fr. Bozant and our parish finance council have been planning to replace the air conditioning for some time now. After a formal study by an engineering firm and consultations with two mechanical design firms, I have chosen a path forward. The proposal that I accepted was the more affordable of the two. The price tag for the equipment and installation is estimated to be \$300,000. Additional fees (roughly 10%) will be added for engineering and design work. This plan includes a system with 15 additional "tons" of air handling capacity. Overcooling will be prevented by an electronic regulation/thermostat system. Built-in dehumidification components will address the upper-level moisture problems along with increased circulation. The plan includes thorough cleaning of our current duct work and an upgrade to our current electrical service components. With the new system, I have asked that the outdoor components be relocated to the driveway, freeing up valuable courtyard space—not to mention less noise and more safety during the coffee hour! In addition, the new equipment will be quieter on the inside of the church and will be rearranged to create more floor space in the two sacristies.

I am told that when the contractor is ready to install the new system, it will require about 3-4 weeks worth of work. The engineering, design and equipment-ordering will take roughly 8 months. Therefore, I anticipate that the work inside the church will occur about mid-March of 2020. Our contractor is familiar with work in churches and we hope to have a minimal impact on our Sunday Mass schedule. I'm very grateful for the expertise of our finance council and other parishioners who have advised me on this project. May St. Patrick pray for us as we continue to bring honor to the Most Hole Trinity through sincere and fitting worship! \sim Fr. O'Brien
