SERVITE DOMINO IN TIMORE

October is a month dedicated to the **Rosary of our Lady.**

I pray that, as this month begins, you might reflect on how you can better incorporate the rosary into your own life of prayer. Don't forget, the Enchiridion of Indulgences tells us, "A plenary indulgence is granted, if the Rosary is recited in a church or public oratory or in a family group, a religious Community or pious Association; a partial indulgence is granted in other circumstances." (n. 48).

Today's bulletin is the first to include a comparison of our **budgeted collection income.** Please notice that just below the report which details last week's collection totals, another box is given. This lower box reports the total money collected through our first collection at Masses. It then compares this number with the amount we budgeted for three months of the year, namely July, August and September. As of now, St. John the Baptist has collected only 67% of what we budgeted, and St. Patrick's has collected 74%. I publish these number as a quick snapshot of our overall financial health. Historically, the summer is a time of lower donations. As such, I anticipate we will make steady progress toward our budgeted goal. A more complete picture of our financial state will be detailed each quarter. Please feel free to bring me any financial questions!

A generous and talented parishioner has volunteered to make a new **"houceling cloth"** for St. Patrick's communion rail. There is a venerable tradition of draping this cloth over the communion rail so as to show yet another reverence toward the Blessed Sacrament. While not in use, the cloth will be draped behind the rail and practically unseen. An example of this cloth while it is in use is pictured below.



Next week I will have a thorough explanation of the tradition and use of this cloth. We will begin using it at our 9:15am Sunday Mass beginning on October 20th. Many thanks to all those who volunteer their efforts, ideas and talents for the betterment of the worship we give to Almighty God!
