A quick update regarding our **parish building committee**. A plumb survey has been initiated which will help us to assess the structural integrity of the church building. We expect the results of this survey very soon. Afterward, our building committee will be able to chart a course for the large improvement projects which I've mentioned in the past.

Finally, I've been in touch with our **air conditioning** engineer about our equipment replacement. They are still in the design phase. It seems that the dimensions of the new equipment poses particular problems for our small campus. They are well-informed about our need to be efficient with our use of space and so I'm confident that an amenable solution will be found.
