SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

We have a wonderful opportunity to hear some of the world's most spectacular organ music. Our own **Mr. B. Andrew Mills** will be sharing with us the fruit of his many labors. He will give a **recital this coming Friday evening, November 22, the feast of St. Cecilia at 6:30pm.** During the recital, the audience will be able to see projections of the organist's feet and hands. Please show your support for Mr. Mills and spread the word about this night of beautiful music!

I am still consulting with parishioners regarding the rites which we will use for the **Easter Triduum.** Today, for the second time, I would like to solicit additional feedback. Thanks to the many parishioners who have already shared their views with me. So that no one may go unheard, I renew my request for feedback. Please call or e-mail about whether our parish should utilize the rites of the Easter Triduum in English using the Ordinary Form of the Roman Rite, or use them from the Latin Extraordinary Form? Starting our planning even at this early stage will allow our musicians and other volunteers to be well prepared for a beautiful celebration of Easter.

As we spend this month of November praying for our departed loved ones, we all know that the prayer of the Mass is the most potent offering we can make for them. Uniting our sacrifices to the one sacrifice of Christ is an inexhaustible font of grace for us! Of course, throughout the year it is possible to take special measures to unite your petitions to the prayer of the Mass by means of **"Mass intentions."** The value of this practice is explained by Pope Paul VI, "the faithful, desiring in a religious and ecclesial spirit to participate more intimately in the Eucharistic sacrifice, add to it a form of sacrifice of their own by which they contribute in a particular way to the needs of the Church and especially to the sustenance of her ministers." When you donate for Mass intentions, not only is your prayer uniquely united to the offering of the Holy Mass, but you also contribute to the functioning of our parish. Our policy here in New Orleans is that Mass stipends from intentions are not given directly to the priest who celebrates, but to the parish. Other ways to unite your petition to the public worship we offer God is by means of candle memorials. These candles primarily bring greater solemnity and beauty to our church building, since they indicate to us what is holy. But also, they serve as way to unite your personal petitions to the prayer of the whole parish. Finally, by sponsoring a memorial in our parish bulletin, you enable us to continue our outreach while requesting the prayers of fellow parishioners for your beloved dead. Please contact our parish office to obtain a Mass intention or a memorial.
