## SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

On this first Sunday of Advent, in the introit verse, the Church reminds all the faithful to lift up their hearts to the Lord. “Ad Te levavi!” It is truly right for us to prepare for the Lord’s descending among us as a newborn by lifting up our lives to Him. This lifting up is a preparation for the arrival of the Lord to come, and a response to the fact that he has already descended!

Advent is a time of preparation for our Lord’s arrival. Preparation can happen in many ways. I sincerely hope that you will adopt a concrete way to prepare for the Lord’s coming. **Good preparation is often the fruit of penance.** If we see this time of Advent as it truly is, a penitential season, then Advent will help us to shed the unnecessary worldly things that distract us from the divine mystery of Christmas. Denying yourself some earthly consolation allows you to make room in your soul where God can better take up His residence. Denying ourselves can also create and free up some more time in our day. That time can be used for prayer and reading which can dispose our soul for the graces that God has for us.

I’d like to encourage you all to consider adopting a concrete resolution so that your Advent may bear the fruit of good preparation for Christ’s arrival. One such practice I want to specifically encourage is **attendance at weekday Mass.** Certainly we all have full schedules, we all have excuses to get extra sleep whenever possible, but in this time of Advent, taking on the practice of giving God more of your time will not go unrewarded! As you know, we have two daily Masses here at St. Patrick’s. Beginning this Advent **I will introduce a very brief homily to our 7:15 a.m. Mass** on Wednesdays and **8 a.m. Mass** on Saturdays so as to fuel your reflection on the day’s readings. As always, we will continue to offer our 11:30am Mass Monday– Friday, followed by the Rosary and Adoration.

**Today also marks the start of our end-of-the-year giving drive.** MANY THANKS in advance to those who will participate in “GiveCatholic Giving Tuesday” on December 3rd. Now both of our churches look forward to the new year with hope, but also with long to-do lists! I wrote a letter specific to St. John the Baptist and St. Patrick’s faithful so that you can be fully informed about the needs and goals of these campaigns. In summary, St. John the Baptist needs to catch up on operating funds and set the financial groundwork for A/C repairs and stained glass window repairs. St. Patrick’s will soon start to feel the pinch of our payments for the new A/C system. In addition to that, we have a great need to care for our church organ. Funds raised by these campaigns are truly necessary for the good of our churches. Your generosity and sacrifices are greatly to be lauded. I have been deeply touched to witness the commitment of so many of our parishioners and their attentiveness to our needs. I wish I could share with each of you the words of admiration that I hear from weekend visitors to our parish. The look on their faces as they leave Mass and the uplifting they experience while they pray help me to keep my enthusiasm for St. Patrick’s parish high. Please know that your financial generosity during this time truly enables our parish to uniquely facilitate a meeting between God and man!

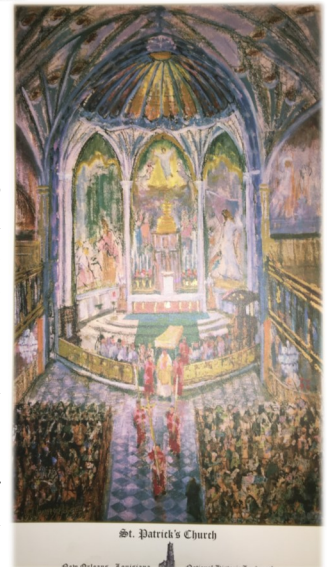
