SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

With just a week and half left of this Advent season, I can imagine that you have many things on the mind: travel, shopping, parties and all the rest. To add to this business, there is a lot going on at our parish too! First of all, we are happy to welcome all of our visitors at St. John the Baptist for this weekend's annual **St. Lucy Society Mass**. Thank you for your dedication to prayer and devotion for St. Lucy! Please know that you're always welcome to our parish! In addition, this week I was able to meet with **potential contractors for our new A/C system** at St. Patrick's. The design phase is finished and now the bidding will begin. Finally, both of our churches are persevering in our **Annual Appeals**. Your contributions are vital to the health and longevity of our churches! I have written a letter for each church explaining the needs and goals of this year's appeals. If you missed it, please find this letter near the front doors of our churches.

The busyness of this season is one thing, but what raises up all that activity and orients it toward the glory of God is the faith that this season stirs within us. Advent facilitates for us a divine encounter: a supernatural outreach from God our Father as He sends us Christ as our brother and Savior. To better prepare for the coming of Christ, please reflect on these words of St. Romanos the Melodist, a 6th century hymn writer from the area of Syria.

"Bethlehem has reopened Eden, and we will see how. We have found its delights in a hidden place, and in the grotto we will regain the goods of Paradise. The root has appeared there, watered by no one, and from it forgiveness has blossomed. The well has been found there, dug by no one, from which David once sought to drink. By giving birth there, a virgin instantly quenched the thirst of Adam and the thirst of David. Therefore let us hurry to this place where the God who is, before all time, has been born as a little child. The Mother's Father, by his own free choice, has become her child; the savior of newborns is a new newborn himself, lying in a manger. His mother meditates upon him and says to him, "Tell me, my child, how were you planted within me; how were you formed? I see you with awe, O flesh of mind, for my bosom is filled with milk but I have had no spouse; I see you wrapped in swaddling clothes, and yet the seal of my virginity remains intact. Indeed, it is you who have preserved it while deigning to come into the world, my child, you who are God before all time."

On this Gaudete Sunday, may the Lord allow you to rest from your labors and widen your hearts to welcome the King of Glory! ~ Fr. O'Brien

ST. MICHAEL & QUEEN OF THE MAY

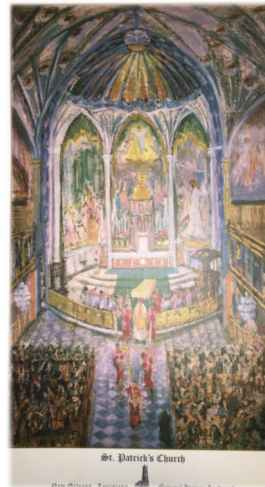
