## SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

I pray that your Advent is off to a very blessed start. While we spend this time of Advent in intense preparation for the arrival of our Lord, we know that we welcome Him into our souls in a profound way each time we receive Holy Communion. So the work of preparation which this season fosters is a life-time's work, a continual work whereby we expand our interior life for the indwelling of God. As the psalmist says, "Lift up your heads, O gates; be lifted, you ancient portals, that the king of glory may enter." (Psalm 24:7)

As I announced last week, **we have begun our Advent Financial Campaign.**

I can't say enough how blessed our parish is with dedicated parishioners, willing to sacrifice for the betterment of our parish. One of the projects we've undertaken was on display last week by Mary's altar. This is proof that when parishioners come together, the needs of our parish are met in abundance.




The campaign this year will attend to the **new A/C needs in church and help to clean the historic organ case** that was affected by high humidity and inadequate air conditioning. Notice the dark discoloration in the photo within the yellow bracket. This is not a shadow; it is a spore growth that, if untreated may permanently discolor the finish of the organ case. Below is another view, closer up.

Just like the high altar, the organ case is original to the architecture of the church building, designed by Mr. Gallagher. The good news is that experts are telling us that we still have time to treat it before permanent damage is done.

While this project's cost is substantial, the need is a pressing one to preserve the beauty and the excellent music program which is a blessing to us all. **Please contribute by means of the envelopes that are in the bulletin and in the pews this weekend.**

## ST. MICHAEL & QUEEN OF THE MAY PRINTS


