SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

Today I pause my series on the Roman Canon to review the results of our end-of-the-year giving campaigns. As you recall St. Patrick's had the goal of funding our new A/C system and cleaning the moisture damage to our organ case. St. John's goal was to cover previous operating expenses and continue saving for maintenance needs, particularly A/C repair and the preservation of the stained glass windows. Today, I'm also presenting our summary financial statement for the first two quarters of our fiscal year.

To begin, our parish benefitted from a significant insurance claim. When Fr. Bozant discovered some financial irregularities his hard work was able to initiate a claim due to those irregularities. Just last month, the claim was processed and our parish was covered for \$125,000 due to what he found. With our parish finance councils, I am still determining what portion of that claim will be allotted to each of our churches. If you would like more information about this development, please feel free to call me.

St. Patrick's Advent Appeal yielded \$103,401. Since these funds will be used in our A/C replacement project, and other projects, here is a brief update. The engineering design work is finished, and just last month we collected bids for the work. The lowest bidder came in at a total of \$276,500, namely Guillory Sheet Metal Works. The contractor has taken on many other church air conditioning projects, including St. Louis Cathedral and Immaculate Conception Church. I will keep everyone updated as the project progresses. By God's grace, this bid was within what we budgeted at the start of the fiscal year. Because of this, I am hopeful that we can end the year with a balanced budget as long as our collection donations remain at their current levels.

The faithful of St. John the Baptist also showed their generosity in raising \$53,345. This includes the generous gift from our matching donor. Please remember, the annual appeal continues until Easter. While the total is less than our overall goal, it has still been a successful campaign. This amount allows St. John to cover operating debts and begin building some savings for maintenance projects and upcoming bills.

Finally, this week, I would like to summarize for you where we stand financially now that we have completed the second quarter of our fiscal year. Combining the totals for our two churches, we have collected \$339,478 in our first collection income. This is 82% of what we budgeted. Our second collection income totals \$119,630. This is 158% of what we budgeted.

Allow me now to broadly compare those totals with our expenses. Since we have not started payments on the new A/C equipment, our budget shows a healthy surplus at the moment. According to my estimations, this surplus will be brought back to balance once the A/C payments begins. The two collection totals, combined with our end-of-the year appeals, and the insurance reimbursement have allowed to have a healthy financial footing. I do not see signs that we will end the fiscal year with a significant deficit. By your generosity our parish continues to be a refuge for all who seek God's beauty and Truth! Let us give thanks to God for the generosity of His providence!

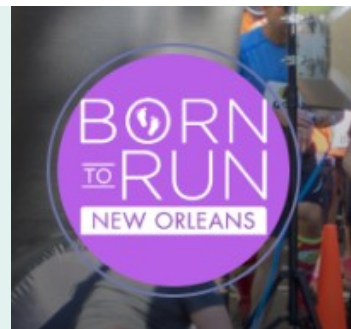
RESPECT LIFE FOCUS JANUARY: ABORTION/UNBORN BABIES
