SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

Weeks ago, I began consultations with many parishioners including our musicians and Altar Guild regarding St. Patrick's celebration of the Easter Triduum. I brought these consultations to Archbishop Aymond and together with him, formulated a plan to provide the Easter Triduum in both forms of the Roman Rite here at St. Patrick's. This is a wonderful development that I believe will allow everyone in our community to be well served in our celebrations of the Easter mysteries. The Triduum will be offered in as follows:

Good Friday	3:00 p.m.	6:00 p.m.
Easter Vigil	8:00 p.m.	4:00 p.m.

More explanation and practical details will be forthcoming!

I am very pleased to announce that St. Patrick's will be welcoming a new convert to the Catholic faith on February 9th. Fr. Bozant began the catechesis for Mr. Christophe Eldridge and I have been able to conclude his preparation. He will make his profession of faith as a Catholic at the 11am Mass and I hope that you have a chance to congratulate him! He has an insatiable appetite for all things Catholic. Christophe, your zealous faith is an encouragement to all of us!

By God's providence, two volunteers repainted Reynold's hall bathroom. Anyone who had used it prior to this knew how much it needed a face lift! Not only did they spend two days cleaning and painting, but they also obtained a donation from the Irish Channel Club to cover the expenses.

Our parish is also in a debt of gratitude once again to our St. Joseph's Guild. Storage space is at a premium on our campus and the additional furniture will be a great help! Please stay tuned for future meetings; the Guild will come together again on February 2nd.

I'd like to update you regarding some maintenance projects at our parish. First, St. John the Baptist faithful will notice some upgrades to the exterior window frames. The paint on these windows has been flaking for years even compromising the wood and allowing leaks. With the help of Mr. Frank Macelli, we will be gradually addressing these issues.

At St. Patrick's you will notice that our sanctuary floor is receiving some much needed attention. A singular donor came forward to sponsor the project of polishing the marble floor. This will allow the marble to be cleaned of old layers of wax and scuff marks while at the same time bring out a beautiful gloss finish.

Thirdly, I invited a structural engineer on a tour of the church to analyze our plumb survey results and inspect for signs of foundation problems. This engineer has worked on St. Patrick's several times in the past. We were also joined by Mr. Andre Villere of the Archdiocesan building office. After the tour, we were able to conclude that there are no major structural problems at present. The plumb survey concluded that the building is not moving significantly. There remain two areas of concerns, however. These are the wooden structural support of the bell tower, and the leaning of the courtyard wall. While these areas need attention, the need is not immediate. As a result, I have decided that we will focus our attention on the A/C project and the cleaning of the organ case until next fiscal year's budget begins (this July).

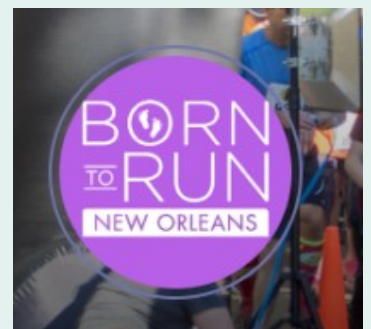
