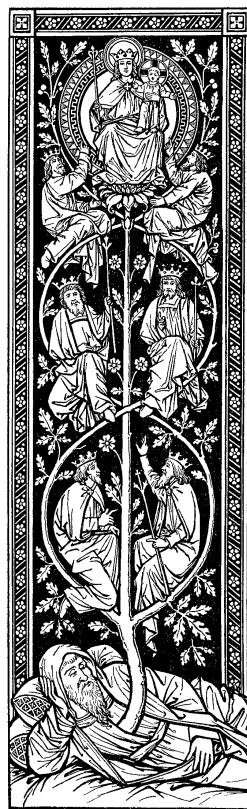

SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

I pray that this new year is off to a very blessed start for you and your families! Usually I use my bulletin articles to update everyone about the various projects going on here at our parish. I'm very optimistic about our financial standing after the generosity of our parishioners in our Advent financial appeals. I look forward to providing more information, but early bulletin deadlines prevent me from doing so this week! Rather than focus exclusively on the financial matters, I'd like to kick off this new year with a bulletin series about the text of the Roman Canon; it's the Eucharistic Prayer that we use every Sunday at Mass. These are the words that the priest prays after the "Sanctus" or "Holy, Holy, Holy."

To you, therefore, most merciful Father, we make humble prayer and petition through Jesus Christ, your Son, our Lord: that you accept and bless ✠ these gifts, these offerings, these holy and unblemished sacrifices, which we offer you firstly for your holy catholic Church. Be pleased to grant her peace, to guard, unite and govern her throughout the whole world, together with your servant **N.** our Pope and **N.** our Bishop, and all those who, holding to the truth, hand on the catholic and apostolic faith.

In reflecting on this prayer, first notice to whom the prayer is addressed. As the priest offers the most sacred prayers of the Mass, he is speaking to the Father. In fact the first word of the Latin text, "Te" means "You." This is not an accident! The authors of these prayers wanted to be absolutely clear about what is happening in this prayer: the Father is being addressed by the Church. Notice that we offer this prayer calling on His mercy and recalling that our prayer is a humble one. What's more, our prayer is addressed to the Father not in our own name, not by our own merits, but through Christ.

Next, we turn our attention to the bread and wine, the *oblata*, or offerings. When we approach the Father we do not do so empty handed; we come with gifts that are "holy and unblemished sacrifices." While these gifts are meagre, they represent the very best of what we have to offer. Of course, at this point, the gifts are still bread and wine! It's not much of an offering, but it is all we have! Plus we come with faith that God will accept our offering and transform them into something so much more!

After we turn our gaze to the Father, (through Christ) and offer our gifts, we make our first appeal to ask for some favor from God. This appeal is the first of many in the Canon and, as you can see, it is a prayer for the Church. The Church truly is the chosen vessel of salvation! Therefore, it makes sense that foremost in our prayer is that the Church would be safeguarded and continue to spiritually mother us toward heaven. By this prayer, we ask the Father to look upon our offerings, see the good things we have made for Him and allow His heart to be moved in generosity so that the Church may be a safe haven on earth for our souls.

Those are just a few of my own devotional reflections to help you to truly "Pray the Mass." In subsequent weeks, I'll reflect on the other prayers which comprise the Canon. I think it is also helpful to understand just how ancient this prayer is! The Roman Canon is known to exist in its entirety already by the time of St. Gregory the Great (590 A.D.) In fact, for many centuries it was the only Eucharistic Prayer allowed in the Latin Rite. We are so blessed to be the heirs of such a rich liturgical tradition!
