## **SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE**

As this long night drags on, it's easy to begin to feel discouraged. Truly, as members of the family of God it is our duty to share one another's burdens. Because of that, I'd like to encourage you in this final week of Lent to take upon yourselves the duty to pray for those impacted by the effects of this virus. Certainly we pray for those who are ill, but we also pray for those who have lost a job, those who feel isolated, those suffering from increased anxiety, and, in particular, those whose faith has been shaken by this turbulent time. Just when we should be assembling to worship the Lord for the awesome works of salvation He wrought for us, we are required to stay apart - unable to experience them yet again in their sacramental form.

During this time we must appreciate once again the blessing of being within the one Church of Christ, that is the Catholic Church. God does not intend his people to be isolated; He established His Church as an assembly. But more than just any group of people, the assembly of the Church is a sacramental assembly. This allows God's faithful to be with one another, but also to be with Him. The same divine logic that moved our Lord to take on flesh and dwell among us, is the same divine logic that established for us the seven sacraments. By them we can be certain God is present among us, and acting in our midst. As beneficial as it is to see the Mass through an online feed, we must remain especially vigilant so as to not lose sight of the reality that God wants us to be in contact with Him and to do this in more than just a spiritual sense. If there is one spiritual lesson to be gained from this ordeal, it is the greater appreciation for the gift of the sacraments!

I am sincerely grateful to those generous parishioners who have continued to send in their contributions. There is much human suffering at this time, and it is right for our focus to be there, but our parish is also suffering due to these restrictions. According to the dictates of prudence, I ask you to support us financially so that we may avoid falling behind on our obligations toward the parish employees and others. With your steady support, and Fr. Bozant's hard work building up parish savings, I am hopeful that we can maintain a stable financial position through this crisis.

Finally, now that we are on the threshold of Holy Week, I implore you, even from a distance, to internalized the great mysteries which unfold over the next several days. Even though we are not obliged to attend the Mass, nonetheless we need the grace of Easter in our lives and in our world. Please take time to be attentive to these things in the best way you are able. In this way, you and I can be a source of God's light for this world gradually pushing back even the night of death. —Fr. O'Brien
