SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

The season of Lent is now upon us. On several occasions in my own life, I have experienced extra graces during this season to go deeper in my own spiritual life. For example, when I was discerning the priesthood as a college student, I made it my Lenten commitment to pray the whole Liturgy of the Hours. God was generous and from that time on, even though I wasn't obligated, I've been able to incorporate more prayer in my daily routine. The same can be said about the time of Lent and my efforts to make a Holy Hour or utilize other practices of prayer that both stretch me and nourish my spiritual life. Likewise, I truly hope that this Lent, you can stir up your faith that the Lord will be generous to you with His grace as you strive to open wide your heart to the Easter mysteries.

In light of this, I'd like to highlight a few ways that St. Patrick's can be part of your Lenten spiritual discipline. First and foremost, I beg you to consider attending **daily Mass**. We have two Masses each day, and if those are not convenient, I guarantee that another local parish has a Mass at a convenient time and place. Daily Mass is the perfect way to find additional spiritual sustenance. Even if you can manage to attend just one weekday Mass between Sundays, you will not regret it! During Lent, our parish is offering some special Masses that will be a great opportunity to benefit from the sacraments. **St. Patrick's Day (March 17), the Annunciation (March 25)** we will host Solemn High Masses at 6:30 p.m. in the evening. On *Laetare* Sunday, (March 22) please join us for **vespers and Benediction** at 4pm. Making good use of the **Sacrament of Confession** is a vital part of Lent. Our parish offers at least 9 hours of Confession weekly. In addition to that, Confession will also be available on March 18, 25 and April 1 from 5:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.

For those of you who attend our Sunday morning Masses, I invite you to take a little extra time to connect with fellow parishioners at our **morning coffee hour**. Coffee is available all morning; thanks to our generous volunteers, pastries are available after 9:15 and 11. Make a resolution this Lent to meet some new people—you're sure to find encouragement from them as we pursue holiness together. **Other opportunities abound whereby you can connect with fellow Catholics;** after evening Mass on March 17, at the March 19th St. Joseph Altar, and our first-ever "Answers & Appetizers" for young adults. At the end of March, I'm glad to announce, our parish will host a weekly Rosary for Artists. It will include time for prayer and community. More details are on the way!

Lastly, the Season of Lent culminates in the celebration of the **Easter Triduum**. Since our parish will offer the Triduum in both forms of the Roman Rite, we need to do some recruiting! These liturgies will be beautifully celebrated, so I pray that you will take this opportunity to invite your family and friends, neighbors and coworkers to join in these profound celebrations of our faith. If we don't spread the word, I'm afraid these liturgies will seem neglected or lacking in their externals. However, with good participation from our congregation and guests, these liturgies will not only be worthy worship for God (our primary aim) but also an uplifting experience of the faithfulness of all those who call St. Patrick's their spiritual home.

With all of these opportunities, it is clear that **our need for helping hands is great!** If one event or another peaks your interest, please contact the parish office about how you can get involved. For some events, a financial donation would be deeply appreciated to cover food or other costs. For other events, just an hour or two of volunteering would be a great blessing. In one way or another, I know that the Lord has some special graces waiting for us this Lenten and Easter. I encourage you to be bold in how you embrace this penitential season!
