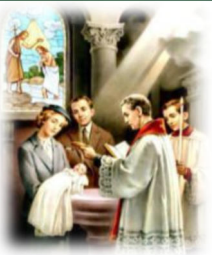

## **SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE**

In the week ahead, we have **several opportunities to draw together as a parish** and enjoy some special events that this time of year provides. First, on March 17th, we celebrate the patron of our parish with a Mass at noon. The Louisiana Hibernians will be present and Archbishop Aymond will be celebrating. In the afternoon, we will have adoration of the Blessed Sacrament at 2 p.m. until 6 p.m. and Mass at 6:30 p.m. Thursday, March 19th is our parish St. Joseph Altar, please come enjoy the fruits of the hard work of our volunteers as we express our devotion to the foster father of Christ. Our young adults (ages 18-35) are welcome to enjoy "Answers and Appetizers" with me on Friday, March 20 from 6:30 p.m. until 8:30 p.m. Then, next Sunday, March 22nd our parish musicians will offer **Solemn Vespers** at 4 p.m. to celebrate *Laetare* Sunday. I hope to see you there!

After these events, Holy Week is not far behind! Please keep in mind the many special events that are offered during that time. The beauty of the music and décor accompanying these liturgies are powerfully able to reach to the heart! If you're able to donate to make these efforts possible, **please consider contributing for our Easter music or our Easter flowers.**

These wonderful activities are a great sign of life and growth for our parish, and they are just the tip of the iceberg! In the fall, **I hope to provide opportunities for organized family catechesis and sacramental preparation through our parish, as well as more events to serve our parishioners.** With this increase of activity I have consulted our Finance Council as well as our Pastoral Council and both agree that it would be wise to **add a part-time position to our parish staff.** This new employee would serve to coordinate the parish apostolates and support their practical needs. If you, or someone you know might be a good fit for this position, please request a job description from the parish office and submit a résumé.

Recently, it was brought to my attention that the **need for a second bathroom** is truly pressing. Our Mass and wedding crowds can easily be inconvenienced by the long line for the restroom. After consultation, we have a plan to make a second bathroom available and the cost should be rather minimal. There is a restroom in the rear of the rectory that could be used by Mass goers, but only after provisions are made to secure access to the rest of the rectory. This will require us to install a wall and a door. Of course, this project was not in our budget for the year so **it is important that some funds are raised especially for this project.** If this improvement project is especially helpful to you, please consider contributing so that we can complete it soon!

With the help of Dr. David Liberto, St. Patrick's is very honored to welcome **Dr. Peter Kwasniewski** for a lecture entitled, "The Traditional Latin Mass and 'Active Participation': Adversaries or Allies?" It will occur on Sunday May 3rd, at 11 a.m. Dr. Kwasniewski is a nationally known lecturer, professor, composer and author who focuses on the many ways that traditional Catholicism can address the challenges of our own day. We are blessed to have this opportunity; please plan to attend!
