Of course, this year provided some new challenges, but despite them all, many people joined together to creatively facilitate beautiful sanctuary decorations and dignified sung Masses to celebrate the Triduum. My deep appreciation to Mr. Gene Luke of Ambrose Garden. his talents and generosity are second to none!

To all those who assisted, I can't express my thanks enough. And truly, I don't have to! I know that all those who helped were not doing it for me, but out of love of the Lord. May He richly reward you!

I was happy to see that our livestreamed liturgies received literally thousands of views online. As successful as it was, I am eager for the day when our pews can be full once again. To our Servers' Guild and our parish musicians, we are deeply indebted to you for the hard work you invested in worshipping our Lord.

I have been truly humbled to see how many of you continue to mail in your donations during this time. These gifts are making a big difference as we attempt to maintain our employees on their full salaries.

Even during the shutdown, some essential construction projects have been continuing. The work to replace our air conditioning system is still on schedule. One of the five units is up and running. We were also able to complete the installation of an additional wall and door in the rectory so that another bathroom will be available on Sundays. A very generous parishioner has been sponsoring repair work at St. John the Baptist. The exterior wooden frames of the stained glass windows had been in disrepair for some time. Now, with his help, these are being sanded and repainted so as to provide many more years of service. Last week, St. John's A/C system experienced a significant pipe break; it was quickly repaired and restored to service. For a while now, the fence at St. Patrick's has been in need of sanding and paint. Due to the generous and diligent efforts of a faithful parishioner, the fence is looking fresh and pristine.

As a final piece of news, I want to inform you that St. Patrick's has been approved for a forgivable loan from the Small Business Administration. This is made possible through the recent CARES act from the US government. These funds will be used to ensure all our employees, including our cantors, can be paid during this time when public Masses are suspended.

On this Divine Mercy Sunday, please be assured of my prayers! If you would like to receive the sacrament of Confession, I am happy to meet you in a safe location and offer the sacrament whenever its convenient.
