SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

After a week of only-10-people-per-Mass, it has been a great joy to welcome some of our parishioners back to church! Paige Saleun has been going above and beyond in her efforts to manage our reservation system. I can't thank her enough for her hard work so that people may return to Mass safely! We do hope to welcome even more parishioner per Mass beginning on May 16. Please look for the latest information on our website.

The Archdiocese of New Orleans has filed for bankruptcy protection by means of a chapter 11 reorganization. This is difficult news, to say the least. Archbishop Aymond has personally made sincere efforts to reassure pastors that these proceedings will only affect the operations and assets of the archdiocesan chancery. Parishes should expect to continue to operate as normal. A commission of priests has been assembled with independent legal council to make sure that parish assets are not implicated in archdiocesan liabilities. As for me, I intend to be 100% transparent to you about any impact the bankruptcy ultimately has on our parish. If you have any question about parish finances, please do not hesitate to call me and discuss your concern.

In light of the imposed lock down, allow me to offer an update regarding our parish finances. Parish Masses were first impacted on March 12th, when Mass attendance was half of normal. Combining St. John the Baptist and St. Patrick's, operating income in March 2019 was \$56,027 and Restoration and Maintenance (R&M) was \$16,915. In March 2020 operating income was \$72,874 and R&M was \$16,051. So, even though crowd sizes were greatly affected, giving was still very strong. Each year, our parish sees a significant increase in collections at Easter time, making April one of our most lucrative months, customarily. In April 2019, operating income was \$97,975 with R&M at \$20,749. With small crowds at Masses in April 2020, operating income was \$55,046 and R&M was \$6,993. In a word, donations this April were cut in half.

First, I want to draw attention to the many parishioners who continued to mail in donations during the lock down. Your love for St. Patrick's and the mission of spreading the Gospel is altogether apparent! For that, I thank God! The lack of donations from the many tourists who visit our churches represents a significant portion of our decrease in income. I am afraid that if the tourism industry in our city is slow, it will have a lingering affect on us into the summer. Second, I have had the goal of supporting our parish employees even during the lock down. To that end we received \$73,000 from the CARES act, and we have maintained wages for employees (including our cantors) as though our operations were carried out normally. This loan is set to become a grant as long as we use it in accord with the program's stipulations. Third, as expected, our payments on the A/C renovation have come due in recent weeks. As you recall this is an expense of about \$300,000. We have been fulfilling these responsibilities with our money on deposit at the archdiocese.

Finally, while the impact of the lock down will be deeply felt by our parish, we can thank God for the lives that it kept safe. Reviewing all this information I am convinced that the goodness of our parishioners and God's providence will most certainly make a way for our parish to continue thriving as our country emerges from lock down. Let me state, once again, my willingness to minister to you in church or in your home in whatever way you may need at this time. As always, be assured of my prayers! -Fr. O'Brien
