Everyone is still dispensed from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass. If you are healthy, we invite you to come to church. Please remember you are safest at home. The 9:15 a.m. Mass is by appointment only. Please do not attempt to attend without a reservation. Fr. O'Brien has added a 1:30 p.m. Low Mass with Organ to accommodate overflow. If you are vulnerable and not feeling well, please remain at home.

The 9:15 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. Masses are available first to St. Patrick's parishioners and then to visitors during this time. **Please call Paige in the parish office at 504-525-4413 between Monday and Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. to make your appointment. Beginning Monday, May 18th, you can make your weekly reservation online at [oldstpatricks.org](http://oldstpatricks.org).** If you do not have access to the reservation system, please call Paige.

### General Guidelines for Mass Attendance:

- We are still dispensed from Sunday Mass obligation, so if you are compromised in any way, feel ill or have been in contact with someone who has been ill, please stay home.
- Please bring your own disinfecting wipes and sanitizer.
- We recommend wearing a mask during Mass. If you choose to receive Communion, please remove the mask.
- Please maintain social distancing at all times, especially during Communion. Pews are roped off every other and if possible, please sit 6' off center aisle.
- As people depart from Mass, social distancing must be observed and social gatherings are allowed in Reynolds Hall or on the sidewalk in front of church.

## **SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE**

For two months, I've looked forward to the moment that I could welcome the crowds back to our Masses, and this weekend we take an important step forward. Now that the governor and mayor have lifted some of the restrictions on crowd sizes, I am pleased to welcome you back to Mass, 100 at a time! We will continue to take precautions to keep everyone well-spaced and separated. Another precaution is a reservation system for our most populous Mass, Sunday 9:15. Please see our website for information regarding how to sign up. I know that so many of you are eager to return to Mass, but allow me to remind you:

- The obligation to attend Sunday Mass is still lifted.
- If you feel any symptoms, or have come in contact with someone who has, you have a duty to remain at home.
- If you are advanced in years or have a compromising health condition you should remain at home.
- Anyone who is hesitant about being around a crowd of 100 people may feel free to attend one of our daily Masses where the crowd is around 20.
- You are safest at home, even healthy individuals do nothing wrong by remaining away from crowds at Mass.
- During phase 1, no social gatherings will be allowed in Reynolds Hall. Please do not linger on the sidewalk after Mass.
- Please wear a mask and gloves in church, except during Communion. Please bring your own sanitary supplies such as cleansing wipes for your pew and hand sanitizer.

If we are diligent, we will pass through phase 1 without any road blocks, and we will be able to continue to return to normal. As this possibility nears, I hope to maintain our plans for some very special Latin Mass events in coming weeks:

The Solemnity of the Ascension will be celebrated with a High Mass on Thursday, May 21 at 6:30 p.m.

Four of our young people will be receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation on Pentecost Sunday, May 31. The Confirmation will begin at 9am.

On Corpus Christi Thursday (June 11) we will celebrate with a High Mass and an outdoor procession with the Eucharist. Mass will begin at 6pm to allow time for the procession before sunset.

We will also celebrate the External Solemnity of Corpus Christi on Sunday, June 14. On this joyful occasion, several children will receive our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament for the first time. Mass will conclude with solemn Benediction.
