The 9:15 a.m. Mass is by appointment only. Please do not attempt to attend without a reservation. Fr. O'Brien has added a 1:30 p.m. Low Mass with Organ to accommodate overflow. If you are vulnerable and not feeling well, please remain at home.

The 9:15 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. Masses are available first to St. Patrick's parishioners and then to visitors during this time. **You can make your weekly reservation online at oldstpatricks.org.** If you do not have access to the reservation system, please call Paige in the Parish Office at 504-525-4413 ext. 1001.

General Guidelines for Mass Attendance:

- We are still dispensed from Sunday Mass obligation, so if you are compromised in any way, feel ill or have been in contact with someone who has been ill, please stay home.
- Please bring your own disinfecting wipes and sanitizer.
- We recommend wearing a mask during Mass. If you choose to receive Communion, please remove the mask.
- Please maintain social distancing at all times, especially during Communion. Pews are roped off every other and if possible, please sit 6' off center aisle.
- As people depart from Mass, social distancing must be observed and social gatherings are not allowed in Reynolds Hall or on the sidewalk in front of church.

The time of the Ascension brings a conclusion to the Easter Season as it allows us to reflect upon the conclusion of our Lord's time on Earth. Along with His incarnation, passion and resurrection, the ascension of the Lord is one of central mysteries in Christ's life. Therefore it serves not only as a final show of splendor, but truly as one more revelation about Christ—Who He is and what His mission is. As such, I hope the hymn below can help you to deepen your meditation on today's great feast. The hymn was taken from the office of Matins of the Roman Breviary for the feast of the Ascension. While the author is unknown, some conjecture that the first verses are the work of St. Ambrose. May the Lord abundantly bless you during this Ascensiontide.
