## SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

Many thanks to all those who attended and assisted with our Corpus Christi procession this past Thursday. What a splendid way to honor our Lord! Thank you to a generous donor who gave the funds for 6 new surplices. The boys and men of our Servers' Guild were very excited to have the new and very dignified vesture!

Today, I would like to give you some parish updates:

First, our new air conditioning system has been up and operating for several weeks now. However, the project is not quite done yet. Since we increased the overall capacity of the air handling units, we are now in the process of calibrating the units to their proper airflow. This adjustment will also attenuate the noise created by the increased wind movement. There is one element of this final stage of the process that you will visibly notice; it pertains to our new dehumidification equipment. One of our new A/C's is specially designed to dehumidify. This will help us to avoid moisture levels that could allow mold to grow once again. In order to provide dehumidified air at the upper levels of the church, two new air vents will be installed on the left side of the church. They will be placed above the decorative wood paneling which is over the Sacred Heart Altar. I expect all these final projects to be done in about four weeks.

Second, please allow me to share some thoughts with you about the impact of Covid-19 on our parish. To begin, the Mass attendance has been obviously impacted. For about 8 weeks we had only the absolute minimum number of people present. Once we were allowed to open our doors to the public, then our numbers increased, but only to about 40% of what would experience on a normal weekend. We cannot be surprised by that, for truly it is prudent for our elderly and vulnerable parishioners to remain at home. I look forward to a gradual increase in our attendance numbers with God's protection and grace! The other factor which impacts our Mass-goers is the fact that tourism is at a standstill in our city. We are normally blessed to welcome many, many visitors each weekend. The recovery of our attendance numbers will vary with the return of tourism.

Third, our parish finance council met last week to review my new budget for next fiscal year, beginning July 2020. They made some very helpful observations and recommendations. Because of the slow recovery, we do expect to see a long-term impact on donation income. In light of this, we adjusted our projected income and reallocated finds so as to maintain our parish's priorities. As a result, we expect to continue tackling building maintenance projects and we also expect to maintain the high quality of our parish sacred music program. Some time later in the summer, I look forward to publishing the annual financial report. In this month of the Sacred Heart, I pray that your families are richly blessed by His generous love!
