SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

Ever since the early Church, several ranks, or orders, had been formed for the service of God's people. These orders quickly developed into a hierarchical system whereby men pursuing the priesthood would gain experience as they attained the higher orders and received sacred ordination as a priest. As early as the year 251, Eusebius in his *Church History* records the number of those who occupied these ranks for the city of Rome. In time, these orders were divided into two categories: major orders and minor orders. The minor orders were porter, exorcist, lector and acolyte. The major orders were subdeacon, deacon and priest. It was in this context that the Mass developed into what is seen when one attends the extraordinary form of the Roman Rite.

After the Second Vatican Council, Pope Paul VI authorized a reform of the Mass. This reform shifted some roles that had been reserved to those in major and minor orders to the lay faithful. With this reform came a significant reorganization of the major and minor orders. In 1973, in his document *Ministeriam quaedam*, Pope Paul VI suppressed the minor orders and the major order of subdeacon. He replaced these with two ministries which are now proper to lay men, namely lector and acolyte. These ministries are unique because they are typically conferred in special ceremonies presided over by the bishop where the lay man is instituted as a lector and acolyte.

There is special reason for this little history lesson! Since St. Patrick's has long offered the extraordinary form of the Roman Rite, and we have done so with great solemnity, I petitioned Archbishop Aymond to allow St. Patrick's instituted acolytes for a very specific reason. Part of Pope Paul's reform was to attribute the duties of subdeacon to those who have received the ministry of acolyte. Therefore, there has been a long standing custom whereby those who have received the ministry of acolyte may perform the liturgical functions of subdeacon. However, since an acolyte is not a cleric, they are not permitted to wear clerical attire, such as the biretta. Also to show that they are not ordained, they will not wear the maniple, other actions at the altar are not permitted of them.

There are two main reasons Archbishop Aymond granted my rather uncommon request. First, he intends for St. Patrick's to maintain our high level of liturgical solemnity, secondly, he wants to provide me the additional help that will allow me more time for sacramental ministry such as hearing confessions and distributing Holy Communion. The three men he has authorized as new acolytes have been involved with St. Patrick's for many years. They have shown dedication to the liturgy and care for our sacred worship. With some additional training, you'll soon see them on the altar in their new role.

Please congratulate Mr. Bobby Ramirez, Mr. Keith Marino, and Mr. Corey Keiper on their institution to the lay ministry of acolyte. This service will be exercised just at our extraordinary form Masses, it does not entail an additional administrative role at our parish or in the archdiocese. This kind gesture of support from Archbishop Aymond will allow me more flexibility and help to beautify our liturgies. As with any call to service, it is not an achievement or a promotion, but it is humiliation (in the best sense). Ministry in the Church at any level is a way to lower oneself in imitation of Christ and become a servant of all.
