That outburst was giving voice to the heaviness of the moment. What should we do when we are tempted to put our life of prayer on pause? If you're feeling like your life of faith may be taking a back seat because of the difficulties of the moment, you're not alone!

Find strength in your brothers and sisters in Christ! It is true, keeping God first requires some creativity when times are difficult, but that is precisely when we can reach out, ask for a helping hand be it from a friend, a spouse, from a priest or a patron saint. Whether you're able to join us in church for Mass, or if you're vulnerable and need to stay home, please know that the gift of Eucharist draws the whole Body of Christ together uniting into a single sacramental moment all of those who have ever received the Blessed Sacrament. Be it inconveniences, natural disasters, or politics—the forces of division are many. But without hesitation, let us profess together that this world and its sorrow is but a blink of an eye. Indeed, what is eternal is already at hand!

Do not allow what is temporary to obscure the eternal gift of faith planted within you at baptism! Have confidence that God is near to us in the present sufferings—His omnipotence will bring good from all things. For our part, let us not neglect our prayer, even if all we can muster is the simple prayer of our Lady, "Fiat!" ~Fr. O'Brien
