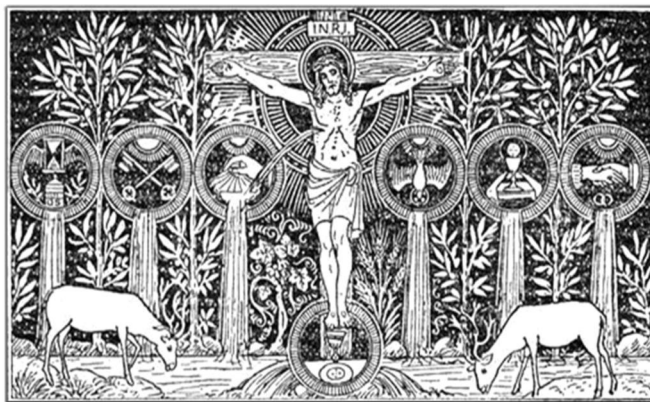

SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

During this month of September, the Church places before us three very special feasts of our Blessed Mother. This past week, we celebrated our Lady's Nativity (September 8) and the feast of the Holy Name of Mary (September 12). This coming week, we reflect on the Seven Sorrows of our Lady (September 15).

The Feast of the Nativity of Our Lady has its origins in the Christian east. As early as the 6th century we see evidence that a liturgical hymn was written to commemorate her birth. Tradition tells us that the date of September 8 was chosen because, on this day many centuries ago, a man had a mystical vision of angels who were singing. He asked them about the cause of their joy and they told him that they were celebrating our Lady's birth. The feast gradually became adopted across the west in the 8th and 9th centuries.



The Holy Name of Mary is due our homage and reverence because, to honor her name is to honor her role in our lives, her place in salvation history and the many graces God poured upon her. We are instructed by the rubrics of the Mass to give honor to her name not only by this feast day, but every time we hear her name by bowing our heads slightly. The liturgical feast originated in Spain around the 16th century. While the date changed a few times, the feast was extended to the whole Church after an important defeat of Turkish invaders of Sobieski which is commemorated on September 12th.

The Seven Sorrows of Mary draw to our attention the specific moments of suffering endured by our Lady during the course of the life of our Savior. The feast day commemorates her spiritual martyrdom and her perfect compassion and participation with the sufferings of Christ. The feast originated in Germany as a response to certain acts of iconoclasm. It gradually spread across southern Europe and in 1727 it was extended to the whole Church.

One very well known element of this feast is the sequence, *Stabat Mater*. Many musical settings of this hymn have been composed. One particularly worthy of your attention is written by Giovanni Battista Pergolesi.
