SACRAMENT PREPARATION



Please take a moment to review the annual financial report that I compiled. Copies can be found in the back of church. In it, I sought to simplify our full financial report so that parishioners could more easily see the general categories of income and expense. Also, with the advise of the Finance Council, I incorporated some more sophisticated accounting tools into the management of our long-term assets. This is particularly relevant to our air conditioning system and other capital improvement projects that we will take on in the near future. Another change this year, is that St. John the Baptist and St. Patrick's have separate financial statements. St. John the Baptist proved itself to be able to operate independent of St. Patrick's subsidies. For this we are grateful and hopeful for a long future. My letter in the annual report tries to cover a lot of ground in a little space, so please, as always, feel free to raise any financial questions with me.

I just received news that the Ancient Order of Hibernians has chosen St. Patrick's as the beneficiary of their annual charity auction. They hope to raise up to \$35,000 to benefit our upcoming restoration work on the church exterior. I will be posting more information on our website



about their efforts in the coming weeks. Let us thank God for the kindness of these faithful Irish Catholic men!

We are very blessed to welcome Mrs. Melissa Mandella to our parish staff. She has accepted the position to serve as our parish bookkeeper. Mrs. Mandella is well experienced with various levels of responsibility in accounting work. She has been at the service of other Catholic institutions in our area as well. With the help of Mrs. Jan Merington, our former office manager, she has already been hard at work to facilitate a smooth transition. I'm so grateful for her willingness to join our team.
