SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

I would like to thank everyone who attended the *Requiem* Mass this past Thursday night. As announced in last week's bulletin, the Mass was offered for the repose of the soul of Mr. Tim Pickles. Tim was a very faithful usher at our 9:15am Mass who died before his time. I was able to visit Tim in his final weeks and days to bring him the sacraments. During that time, I could visibly see the working of God's grace as Tim valiantly carried his cross. When he was nearing the end, Tim asked me to care for a precious reliquary that he had rescued. Pictured below is the antique cross-shaped reliquary he donated to St. Patrick's. For this gift and for the dedication of his service and friendship, Tim will be fondly remembered. Please keep his repose in your prayers.



A few weeks ago, a parishioner asked me to clarify something about our 9:15am Latin Mass. She noticed when I take my seat during the chanting of the *Gloria* and *Credo*, that some parishioners sit when I do, and others stand. Understandably was seeking a clarification. In fact, uniformity of posture for the congregation was something that arose around the time of Second Vatican Council. *Sacrosanctum concilium* #30 said that the people's participation can be fostered by inviting them to take part in common gestures and postures. The *General Instruction of the Roman Missal* #96 clarifies that the unity of the body of believers becomes expressed as the congregation observes postures together. Prior to this instruction, there were no explicit expectations for the postures of the laity during the Mass. As such, I am happy to observe the customs which are proper to each form of the Roman Rite. For our Latin Masses, therefore, this means that those who are edified by standing while singing the *Gloria* and *Credo* are welcomed to do so. Those who prefer to follow the custom of being seated as the priest sits, are equally within their right. St. Paul tells us we are, indeed, one body perhaps this is the chosen emphasis of the Ordinary Form of the Roman Rite. St. Paul also teaches that there is great diversity within this body, such emphasis is portrayed in the Extraordinary Form. Let me encourage you to continue to reflect on the meaning and significance of our sacred liturgies! ~Fr. O'Brien

68TH ANNUAL RED MASS, OCTOBER 5TH, 2020

Most Reverend Gregory M. Aymond, Archbishop of New Orleans, will be the principal celebrant. Reverend Mike Kettenring, a priest of the Archdiocese of New Orleans, will be the homilist. Members of the bench and bar of the State of Louisiana, as well as the public, are invited to attend. Masks are required and social distancing will be observed in the Cathedral.
