St. Patrick's Church Information Booklet for Child Baptism

The birth of a baby into a family is always a time of joyful celebration. It is also a time of recommitment for the parents to the responsibility of rearing the child as God intends.

Infants & children <u>under age 7</u> may be presented for the Sacrament of Baptism. Baptisms are scheduled in conjunction with your intended celebrant (priest or deacon) and the parish calendar.

<u>Baptism Preparation Seminar</u> – Prior to the Sacrament of Baptism, <u>parents and godparents</u> are required to attend one Baptism Seminar. Seminars are scheduled through the parish office.

Children <u>over age 7</u> who need to be baptized follow a different process of preparation. Please contact the parish office.

Selecting Godparents

Parents have the first duty to form their children in faith. (canon 774.2) Godparents commit themselves to support the child's parents in this duty and must, "set an example for those who believe, in speech, conduct, love, faith, and purity." (1 Timothy 4:12) Because of this supremely important duty, at least ONE godparent (sponsor) must meet all the qualifications outlined below (canon 874):

- Be <u>sixteen</u> years of age.
- Be a Catholic who has received the <u>Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist and Confirmation</u> and who leads a life of faith in keeping with the function to be taken on. <u>This indicates that Catholics cohabitating</u> (living together without marriage) and Catholics publicly living in an invalid marriage are ineligible. <u>Invalid marriages</u> (or marriages "outside the Church") are those which are not according to Catholic <u>Church regulations</u>.
- Not be bound by any canonical penalty legitimately imposed or declared.
- Must not be the father or the mother of the one to be baptized.
- A person who was baptized into a non-Catholic ecclesial community (Protestant church) may not be admitted except as a Christian witness to baptism together with a Catholic sponsor/godparent. People who have been baptized Catholic but who no longer practice their faith may not serve as a Christian witness but are invited to speak with a priest about returning to the faith.

Additionally, canon 873 tells us that one sponsor, male or female, is sufficient; but there may be two: one of each sex. This means that there cannot be two sponsors of the same sex, and there cannot be more than two sponsors.
