
SUNDAY 1:30 P.M. LOW MASS

SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

We are very blessed by the musical talents of Mr. Andrew Mills. I hope you can join us this Wednesday Evening at 6:30 p.m. for an **Evening of Organ Music**. Surely the occasion will provide a much needed moment of beauty to lift our hearts!

Pictured below is more information about our goals for the **iGiveCatholic campaign**. These articles will add beauty to our liturgies and our campus. Log on to the website to participate, or use the envelopes located in the back of church. The **Holy Week Lecterns** are used on Palm Sunday and Good Friday for the three deacons who chant the passion. Lecterns resembling these can be found everywhere from St. Peter's Basilica to the humblest parish church.

The **Tenebrae Hearse** is a very unique candle holder, also used during Holy Week. It holds 15 candles in a triangular shape. During Matins and Lauds of the Holy Triduum 14 psalms and a canticle are prayed. After each of these, a candle is ceremoniously extinguished representing the Church's vigil for the rising of the Son on Easter Sunday.

The **niche** will serve to enshrine the statue of Our Lady which was donated recently. A local architect and parishioner has been designing a niche based on the one pictured. And it will grace St. Patrick's near the side entrance.

The **outdoor crucifix** is a somewhat ambitious project on my part, I must admit! But eventually I would like to place a large Calvary scene to be visible from the sidewalk for our passers-by. Such outdoor shrines are common in Europe and can truly move the heart to a moment of prayer.

If the response to this initiative is generous, we can accomplish some beautiful things for our parish!


