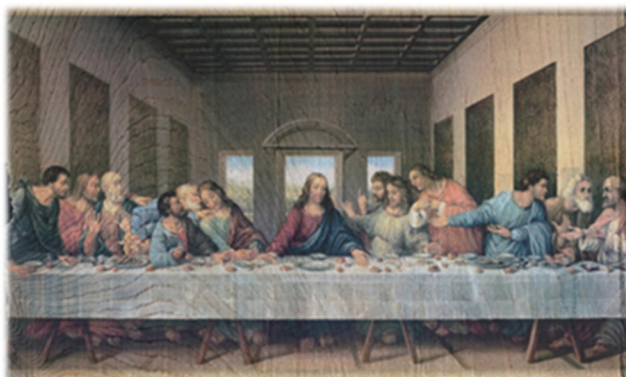

Two of our upcoming capital improvements are gaining steam. Before moving ahead, I would like to ask for the feedback of parishioners. First, pictured on the left, below, is the courtyard wall whose masonry has long been failing. The problems are so significant that bricks are loose and could fall at the slightest nudge. A repair was attempted about three years ago, but it only addressed the upper portion. After consulting with our parish Building Committee, we would like to know if parishioners are opposed to removing the top 8 feet of the wall, bringing the total height to 12 feet. The remaining 12 feet would stay as-is, and would be repaired. The yellow dashed line shows what the new height will be once the top is removed. Removing the top will allow us to ameliorate the upper structural problems and provide us with original brick to repair the damaged bricks on the bottom. Since this project would affect a very visible element of our campus, I am relying on your opinions and views about how best to proceed in a way that is sensitive to our budget and the beauty of our campus.

Secondly, many years ago, St. Patrick's was blessed with an original sculpture by New Orleanian, Lin Emery. I have been thinking to replace this sculpture with something that better aligns with St. Patrick's aesthetic. One possibility is an Outdoor Crucifix like the one pictured in the iGiveCatholic box below. I have done some initial research into the provenance of the sculpture, as well as how to repurpose it in a way that is respectful for the piece. Now, I'm hoping for parishioners to share their views with me about our next step.

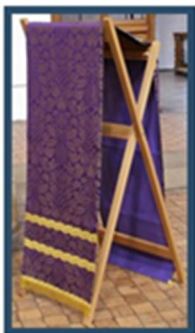

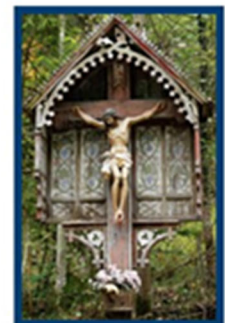
