

First, allow me to express my gratitude to Mr. Mills and our parish musicians for the superb celebration of Solemn Mass for All Souls Day. I know that all those in attendance were deeply edified and truly moved to prayer. Let us keep in mind to continue our prayer for the departed throughout this month of November. Due to crowd restrictions in this time of COVID, the Holy See has expanded the time frame in which the faithful can obtain a plenary indulgence. The indulgence can be obtained by visiting a cemetery or a church to pray for the dead at any time during the month of November. With all indulgences, the usual conditions are to be observed.

As we prepare for the end of the calendar year, allow me to draw your attention to our end-of-the-year fund raising efforts. First, the Louisiana Hibernians have incorporated St. Patrick's as a beneficiary of their annual Charity Auction. Please support their auction and our next building project will be blessed! Next, iGiveCatholic is coming up as well. If these efforts are successful, several small projects stand to benefit. It will help supply furniture for our Holy Week liturgies as well as add beauty to our campus.

Finally, both St. Patrick's and St. John the Baptist have significant capital needs. After several months of planning and consulting, a successful appeal is within reach if our parishioners maintain the generous support for which they are know. St. John's Annual Appeal will benefit major renovations to the air conditioning. Phase one of that project is estimated to be \$21,000. St. Patrick's Advent Appeal has the potential to complete three major improvements needs: the rebuilding of our courtyard wall (\$30,000), the repair of our bell tower (\$40,000), and the exterior church waterproofing and cleaning (\$225,000). In the upcoming bulletins, I'll try to detail these projects-working together is the only way to meet our goal!

I'm grateful to our parish Building Committee and Finance Councils who have aided me in planning for these projects. Let us all give glory to God as we see our parish continue to flourish!


