SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

With the end of September, we have concluded the first quarter of our fiscal year. With that in mind, I'd like to give a financial update. St. Patrick's first collections have totaled \$139,443; and we've budgeted to date \$137,750. Second collection income has been \$43,343, where as we've budgeted \$37,500. Extraordinary income is slightly low at \$55,575 with a budgeted \$64,162. For the purposes of this at-a-glance update, I'll combine our restoration expenses with our operating expenses for a total of \$192,937. This compares well to our budgeted expenses to-date of \$218,639.

St. John's operating collection totaled \$9,075 with \$8,750 budgeted. Restoration collections have gathered \$9,402, while we budgeted to-date \$7,500. Extraordinary income is a little behind at \$1,457 of \$1,900 budgeted. Expenses are healthily within budget at an actual total of \$20,561 of \$26,125 budgeted. St. John is preparing for some major work to be done on their A/C system as soon as plans are finalized.

Last week, I decided to share some more information about the damage that St. Patrick's suffered at the hands of a former employee. I took that occasion to detail the many financial and operating changes that have taken place since 2018. In that, I mentioned that a new money counting team was recruited. I am afraid that the way I presented that information could have been interpreted such that the money counters were part of the problem. However, it is very important for me to clarify that at no time were any of the money counters under suspicion for aiding the fraud that our parish suffered. In speaking to them recently, I learned of their long time dedication to their duties and their sincere efforts for accuracy and integrity. The reason a new teams was formed pertained to the retirement of the previous money counters, a well earned rest for our volunteers, many of whom were octogenarians. With financial matter on the mind, please let me draw your attention to some upcoming fundraisers. First, the Louisiana Hibernians have named us as a beneficiary of their 2020 Charity Auction. The bidding starts on November 7 and concludes November 15. More details will follow. We're very blessed to be included in this wonderful effort. Also the iGive Catholic campaign will conclude with "Giving Tuesday" on December 1. This effort will target some modest beautification projects for our church and campus. Finally, both of our churches will have their end of the year campaigns as well. Much more will be said about these efforts in the weeks to come.

Finally, it is with gratitude to God that I acknowledge the generosity and faithfulness of our parish's two St. Louis Medallion award winners. The St. Patrick's recipient is Mrs. Connie Holden. The recipient for St. John the Baptist is Mr. Frank Macelli. The original date of the award ceremony was moved due to the pandemic, but, at last, our honorees will receive their medallion on Sunday, October 18 from Archbishop Aymond. ~Fr. O'Brien
