SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

For centuries, the “O Antiphons” have accompanied the prayer of the Church in the final days of the season of Advent. They constitute the antiphons which adorn the *Magnificat* at vespers from December 17th to the 23rd. These have been formulated into the hymn “O Come, O Come, Emmanuel.” The final O Antiphon addresses our Savior as Emmanuel, God with us:

O Emmanuel, Rex et legifer noster, exspectatio gentium, et Salvator earum: veni ad salvandum nos Domine Deus noster.

O Emmanuel, our King and Lawgiver, the Expected of the Nations and their Savior, come to save us, O Lord our God.

These words remind us of the full impact of the Christmas narrative. While our modern world may dilute Christmas into a season of generosity or harmony among peoples, these are but a shadow of the fullness of the great feast of our Savior’s birth. No amount of philanthropy could compare with great work to be accomplished by the Christ-child. Therefore, this O Antiphon is a vivid reminder of the depth of our need as well as the true cause of our joy. We need a Savior who uniquely is able to preserve us from the punishment we justly deserve; One who is capable of saving not only a few, but all the nations as well. This is reason we cry out to the Lord our God, as the text directs us.

Salvation is a theme that all of us have reflected on, in one form or another, this past year. Threats old and new have gained ground in our personal lives and in our world. In the midst of social strife, many have looked to political leaders to save us. In the midst of the medical emergency, many have placed their hope in science or in a vaccine to save us. We know well, therefore, this wearisome dynamic of danger and safety, risk and salvation.

With this practical experience on our minds, we are well prepared to assess a new the grace which is granted at the birth of Christ. The danger of eternal death and the risk of being condemned forever to solitude from God are realities that far surpass any earthly difficulty of this past year. The final days of Advent are a perfect time to think about these exceedingly unpleasant things so that we may fully rejoice that to us is born a Savior!

The search for hope is ingrained in the human heart. While we may look for hope in natural sources around us, the truth of Christmas pertains to a supernatural hope. Because a Savior has come, we now hope for what is beyond this world. Therefore, I sincerely pray that this Christmas-tide brings you a reprieve from your worries and rest for your labors, but more importantly, may God’s grace be abundant in allowing you to find supernatural hope because our God comes to save us! ~ Fr. 
