This is a true sign of love for our parish and a concrete display of devotion to beautify the liturgy. Thank you! With a successful start to our fundraising efforts, our focus now shifts to the Advent Appeal and St. John the Baptist's Annual Appeal. The goal for these efforts is much more significant. St. Patrick's is in the midst of cleaning and repairing the cracked stucco on the exterior of our church, and St. John is in need of upgrades for the air conditioning system. As the pandemic response continues, we must do our best to plan for a safe way to celebrate Christmas Masses. Due to the crowd size at our Midnight Mass, I have decided to celebrate our Christmas day Mass at 9:15 a.m. in the Extraordinary Form. Historically, this Mass is the least attended of the English Christmas Masses. Being celebrated in Latin, it will provide an alternative for those who prefer a Latin Mass with a smaller crowd. The Mass will be a Low Mass with Carols. At our current allowed capacity, I do not anticipate needing a reservation system to attend our Christmas Masses.

This upcoming week, St. Patrick's is blessed to welcome Fr. Charles Esuaiko who will be moving into the Rectory as a student priest. He is from Nigeria and has been sent by his diocese to study at Loyola University for the next 18 months. Fr. Charles is looking forward to meeting everyone and helping with Mass and Confession when he is available. FAMILY FUNDAMENTALS

The word "advent" means the arrival of a notable person or thing, and the season of Advent points to the coming of the most notable person of them all: **Jesus Christ**. Advent points to three "comings" of Christ: (1) His first coming as a babe in Bethlehem; (2) His coming into our hearts at our Baptism; and (3) His coming as the Great



Judge at the End of the World. Further, He also comes to us at every Mass to nourish and strengthen us as we wait to see Him face-to-face one day.

In each case, Christ's coming is a reminder that our salvation is always initiated by Him. We do not go to Him; he comes to us. We have no power to save ourselves, so we must allow Him to come to us.
