# SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

Sincere thanks are in order for all of those who made this Christmas season so beautiful! Volunteers at both St. John the Baptist and St. Patrick's were instrumental in cleaning and decorating the churches as well as contributing to the music and the serving. Fr. Roux and I feel privileged to serve such devoted souls! A special thank you to all of our singers who participated in our Lessons and Carols this past Sunday. Mr. Mills led our adult choir as well as our children's choir in a stellar presentation of Christmas music, ancient and modern! If you missed the event, feel free to find a recording on our parish Vimeo page.

With so much uncertainty in our world, I had no way to predict the outcome for our **two end-of-the-year financial appeals**. By your generosity and God's fidelity, we have come very close to meeting our goals. St. John the Baptist's Annual Appeal has raised \$17,030. This effort continues until Easter and will be generously matched by a very kind donor up to \$20,000. These funds will be applied to repairs and improvements for St. John's aging air conditioning. Contribution envelopes are available near the front door of church.

St. Patrick's faithful have also shown their kindness! St. Patrick's Advent Appeal has totaled \$96,554. This is a great start toward covering the cost of our exterior waterproofing project. With the other building and maintenance fundraising this year, I project that we will be able to proceed with all three projects mentioned earlier: the waterproofing, the bell tower beam restoration and the repair of the courtyard brick wall.

Several parishioners have voice their support of relocating the Lin Emery mobile sculpture that stands outside to the left of the church doors. The same location will be used for a large outdoor crucifix. Since I received so much support for the project, I have proceeded to finalize the design of the piece, acquire a cypress beam to fabricate the cross and a cast-iron corpus that will be repainted by a local liturgical artist. Since the Emery sculpture has been part of St. Patrick's for so long. I am happy to hear any additional feedback our parishioners may have, especially regarding its new home. Please contact me if you have any questions or comments.

The St. Joseph's Guild was very blessed by your interest in their first-ever furniture raffle. Over \$800 were raised and the Jones family was the lucky winner of the desk and shelf. The Guild very kindly dedicated a portion of the funds toward helping the needy of our neighborhood and sponsoring a picnic for our altar servers and their families.

Our collection of lost articles has grown to overflowing. If you

believe that you have lost something here in church, please contact the parish office or speak to an usher to claim your lost article. Items include hand missals for the Latin Mass, chapel veils, rosaries, a black diaper bag and other children's articles. Items that are not claimed this week will be distributed to the public.

Finally, it is always a joy to receive Christmas cards and family photos from parishioners. The gifts and treats were so very touching for me and our rectory guests. **Thank you** for the many ways you have shown me your kindness and generosity in this Christmas season!
