Text: *Be Thou with them, dear Lord and Father; their lives and souls dost Thou unite! O how bless'd are they, Thy children, when in Thy Spirit living, moving, they grow in love before Thy sight.*

2. *Be Thou my vision* (Irish melody called *Slane*)

Text: *Be Thou my Vision, O Lord of my heart; Naught be all else to me, save that Thou art. Thou my best Thought, by day or by night, Waking or sleeping, Thy presence my light.*

*Be Thou my Wisdom, and Thou my true Word; I ever with Thee and Thou with me, Lord; Thou my great Father, I Thy true son; Thou in me dwelling, and I with Thee one.*

*High King of Heaven, my victory won, May I reach Heaven's joys, O bright Heav'n's Sun! Heart of my own heart, whatever befall, Still be my Vision, O Ruler of all.*

1. *Panis angelicus* (Franck)

Text: *The Bread of angels becomes food for men: this heavenly Bread puts an end to symbols: O wondrous thing! that a poor and humble servant should feast upon his Lord.*

*O God, One in three Persons, vouchsafe to visit those who adore Thee. Lead us by Thy paths to that light wherein Thou dwellest, and towards which all our desires yearn.*

2. *Ave verum Corpus* (Mozart)

Text: *Hail, true Body! Born of the Virgin Mary, Who didst truly suffer and wast slaughtered upon the Cross for men, from Whose pierced side flowed a wave of Blood: be to us a foretaste [of the heavenly banquet] in the agony of death*

3. *Come, my Way, my Truth, my Life* (Vaughan Williams)

Text: *Come, my Way, my Truth, my Life; Such a Way as gives us breath, Such a Truth as ends all strife, Such a Life as killeth death.*

*Come, my Light, my Feast, my Strength; Such a Light as shows a Feast, Such a Feast as mends in length, Such a Strength as makes his guest.*

*Come, my Joy, my Love, my Heart; Such a Joy as none can move, Such a Love as none can part, Such a Heart as joys in love.*

4. *When love is found* (English melody called *O waly waly*)

Text: *When love is found and hope comes home, Sing and be glad that two are one. When love explodes and fills the sky, Praise God and share our Maker's joy.*

*When love has flow'red in trust and care, Build both each day that love may dare To reach beyond home's warmth and light, To serve, and strive for truth and right.*

*Praise God for love, praise God for life, In age or youth, in husband, wife. Lift up your hearts! let love be fed Through death and life in broken Bread.*
