



SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

After several weeks of other topics, I'd like to revisit my series about Eucharistic theology. After spending a few weeks on the Old Testament, we can begin looking at the New Testament in depth as a way of better understanding the gift of the Eucharist. We start with the Gospels.

We are all familiar with the story of our Lord's birth, but sometimes we miss the Eucharistic overtones contained in the details. Our Lord was born in Bethlehem, which translated, means "house of bread." Since there was no place for Him in the inn, He was placed in a manger. This is the place where the animals would eat. (Lk 2)

When tempted by Satan in the desert, the Lord says that we do not live by bread, but by God's Word. The Word of God, Jesus Christ, will provide us a spiritual Bread that sustains us in ways earthly bread never could.

In the Gospel of John, our Lord says that unless a grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains a

single grain. If it dies, however, and is planted in the ground, then it produces much fruit. This is a symbol of our Lord. By His death, He is planted in the tomb. Yet this death is not the final defeat. Instead, by dying He produces much fruit for all the members of His body. Like a grain of wheat, He allows His body to die, produce a rich harvest and be formed into the Eucharistic Bread which sustains us, the mystical Body of Christ.

Finally, it is fascinating to notice that the two times our Lord predicts Judas' betrayal, the prophecy comes in a Eucharistic context. In John chapter 6 (which I'll address in a future column) the Lord mentions that one of the Apostles is 'a devil.' (Jn 6:70). Also, at the Last Supper our Lord foretells Judas' evil deed. Fulton Sheen reflects that the Eucharist was the first crack in Judas' faith and his priesthood. Next time, I'll look more closely at the Last Supper and the miracles when our Lord multiplied loaves. \sim Fr. O'Brien
