SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

Two weeks ago, I requested for our Latin Mass goes to express their gratitude in writing to Archbishop Aymond for his support of our community. Your response has been overwhelming! I'm very grateful for your letters and, once compiled, I look forward to sharing them with Archbishop Aymond. My other purpose for asking for your letters was to demonstrate all the positive aspects of the Traditional Latin Mass. I felt this was important since there exists a negative perception attached to the Traditional Latin Mass. As such, in my bulletin articles, I plan to share excerpts with you from those letters. Don't worry, I will anonymize your writings, after all, the Mass and our love for the Mass are for the glory of God!

As the eighth psalm says, "*ex ore infantium et lactantium perfecisti laudem.*" Thus, I'd like to begin this series with the reflections of children on the Latin Mass. The first comes by way of a parent who, on one occasion, asked their child about what occurs during the Mass. This young girl, as her first response replied, "A priest holds up a Host." When asked what else happens, she continued, "And a chalice." Her childlike pronunciation which sounded like "jalice" warmed the hearts of her parents. They were also encouraged to hear that the double consecration of Body and Blood were foremost on the mind of their daughter when she thought about the Mass. By this we can see clearly that the rituals of the Mass are forming our young people to notice the presence of Christ. As such, they know early how to orient their lives toward this immeasurable gift!

A young lady of 12 writes that she is uplifted by the beauty she finds in the liturgy. "I like it because it's lovely confessionals and art works." She feels a sense of accomplishment in learning the Mass parts, "Now I know how to say the *Gloria, Credo, Pater, and kyrie.*" Also vital, is her appreciation of the fellowship we enjoy, she writes, "I have friends now because there are more children and their families stay afterwards to visit." A young man who assists at the altar expresses his gratitude saying, "It is with great joy that I will be able to continue to serve the Latin Mass. Serving the Lord has always brought me great joy and pleasure." Another looks forward to the day that his little sister can share in the Blessed Sacrament saying, "I would like for my little sister to make her First Communion at a Latin Mass."

With these reflections, I hope to encourage all of you, whichever Mass you attend, to reflect on the graces you receive at Mass. Offer your gratitude to God for them! Doing so will help us to participate with mind, heart and body in the sacred action of Christ at the altar. Thanks be to God that these young children are already sincerely engaged in the Holy Mass, and thanks be to their faithful parents!
