Roux for coordinating this project and the generous donor who made it possible!

At St. Patrick's, we are attending to plumbing, air conditioning, and electrical needs in the rectory. Thanks to the men's club who is planning some painting projects in the courtyard. I have also begun discussions with a roofer to address the various leaks in the church and rectory. Gradually, progress is being made on our bell tower—some parts to repair the bell tower louvers are on back order. But aside from this speed bump, the project is on track! Now there remains only the repair and repainting of the back façade of the tower.

Life is not all about work, summer teaches us that lesson well! We have several gatherings this summer to enrich the life of our parish. First, this past Friday was our second installment of Answers and Appetizers. Thanks for Fr. Jeffery Montz and all the young adults who made the event a very enjoyable and edifying occasion! 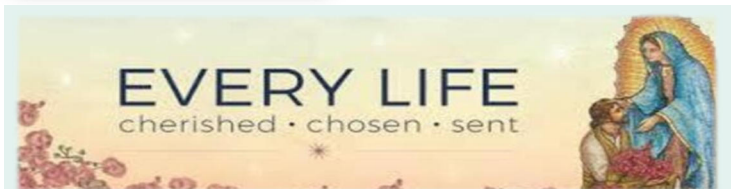
FAMILY FUNDAMENTALS
