SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

What an absolute joy to welcome back Fr. Cassian Edwards, OSB, for the celebration of a solemn Mass thanking God for the gift of his ordination! Fr. Cassian told me how deeply touched he was by the encouragement and support shown by our parishioners during the event last Sunday. As a gift, the parish gave him a set of altar cards (pictured right). He promises to pray for us when he uses them!

I would like to continue today to share with you the testimonies submitted by parishioners following Archbishop Aymond's response to *Traditionis custodes*. The author of the excerpt below expresses the way that she encounters the true, the good and the beautiful in the both the *Novus Ordo*, as well as the traditional Latin Mass. At the same time, her experience is that the Latin Mass sets a particular context that challenges us to do our best, particular regarding the transcendence of beauty.

She writes, "Finally this Mass is beautiful in the best way, because we offer the best of what we have to give glory and honor to our Lord. We offer the best music, the best sacred vessels and embroidered vestments, not at all for ourselves but with the spirit of the sinful woman who poured out the best and most fragrant aromatic nard to anoint the feet of her Lord and Master. We offer the best, and the good Lord offers Himself; it is a most marvelous exchange which is intimate and loving." Insightfully, she continues, "The reverent *Novus Ordo* also participates in this great, sacred tradition which is the lifeblood of the Church. When we have both the new and the old liturgies to draw from, we have a double portion of the Spirit which longs so much for unity in the Church as a whole."

Many of those who contributed reflections on the Mass echoed this theme of the beauty of the liturgy. A gentleman writes, "[The traditional Latin Mass] is beautiful, and I cannot help wishing to be part of something offered to God that is more than just lawful and licit. It gives me joy to participate in a liturgy that asks more of me. In its solemnity and dignity, it possesses an air of seriousness — not grim, joyless, rule-bound priggishness, but the seriousness of knowing that its inviting us into an awesome, wonderful Truth that changes everything for the better." This gentleman's wife, a convert to Catholicism, writes, "The dignity and solemnity of the TLM spoke to my heart in a new and powerful way... It was the TLM that convinced me that there was a home for me in the [Roman Catholic] Church where I can worship God with the dignity and reverence He deserves."

I pray that these testimonies inspire you to reflect more profoundly on the specific fruits that the Holy Spirit grants you at the Holy Mass. Let us redouble our prayers of gratitude, and ever seek to make a more perfect offering of ourselves to God at Mass.
