

SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

To begin, congratulations are in order! Among our parishioners are graduated high school seniors who will soon be headed off to college. To them, I extend my prayers—we are very proud of their good work and faith! Also, congratulations to Rev. Cassian Edwards, OSB, who will celebrate a Solemn Mass of the Thanksgiving. He was a parishioner of St. Patrick's from his youth and was ordained to the priesthood last May and now we have the opportunity to celebrate with him next Sunday at 9:15 a.m.

This week, I have the pleasure of relaying to you another excerpt from a parishioner addressing what they appreciate about the Traditional Latin Mass. Regarding mystery, he writes,

“There is nothing wrong with Mass being a little weird and unlike everything else in our lives....The TLM preserves and celebrates sacred mystery, in a way that is spiritually nourishing.... Everything we know about human encounters with God, whether in sacred scripture or in private revelation, is characterized by mystery. It is precisely the element of mystery that moves us to adoration, so that any encounter with God that's stripped of mystery can only be regarded as untruthful, inauthentic, unreal -- a failed encounter. In short, insofar as the Mass has any emotional effect, it ought to shake us up and take us out of our comfort zone. It should prod us to ponder, to consider what's wrong with us, and how only God can fix it. It's OK for the TLM to feel like stepping into another world -- not hostile, but awesome and entirely different from what we are accustomed to.”

By inviting us to ponder divine mysteries, God elevates the mind and the soul. By incorporating verticality into our prayer, our ritual and even our architecture, the Holy Mass makes tangible heavenly realities.

As we move through this Year of the Eucharist, I have continued to focus my gaze on Christ in the Eucharist by increasing time in adoration. I have been striving to exercise my “still muscle.” I recently heard a friar talk about this “muscle.” He explained that in our hyper-stimulated, world we often struggle to retreat and **rest** with Jesus. He went on to say that it takes true work and perseverance to enter into the stillness and allow our minds to be filled with Him alone. It is like the muscles we use to run, jump, or even walk: we must exercise, stretch, and practice using those muscles. It is the same for our interior life- we must practice stillness. Even with distraction, lack of self-discipline, and constraints on our time, let us resolve to continue resting in Him in adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.
