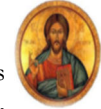


Confirmation Classes

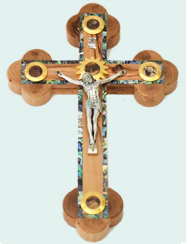


RCIA

Workers are already in the process of fabricating another. We are deeply indebted to the volunteers who assisted to clean up the leaves and branches at both churches!

Among those parishioners with whom I've spoken, only a few have said their hurricane damage was significant. If our parish can help you in any way to aid your recovery process, I truly hope you will reach out to me! While our churches and homes were largely spared, please be mindful of the many in the river parishes, Houma area and down river who still have a long road of recovery ahead. FAMILY FUNDAMENTALS

In 2005 Pope Benedict XVI met with children who had recently celebrated their First Communion. A little girl asked the Pope about his memories of his First Communion. His gentle reply filled me with joy: "...of course I remember my First Communion day very well. It was a lovely Sunday in March 1936, 69 years ago. It was a sunny day, the church looked very beautiful, there was music.... There were so many beautiful things that I remember. There were about 30 of us, boys and girls from my little village of no more than 500 inhabitants. But at the heart of my joyful and beautiful memories is this one - and your spokesperson said the same thing: I understood that Jesus had entered my heart, he had actually visited me. And with Jesus, God himself was with me. And I realized that this is a gift of love that is truly worth more than all the other things that life can give."

As Catholics we know that the Eucharist is at the heart of all we are. As we approach the new catechetical year, we ask that you prayerfully consider enrolling your little one in St. Patrick's First Sacraments program. We will be meeting once a month until May and using a family-based catechesis that provides home lessons for the Sundays we do not meet as a class. The first four months will be in preparation for First Reconciliation and the following four months will be centered on preparing your child to receive their First Communion. What a joy it will be to walk with you and your child during this pivotal point in their formation! Please contact the office for an application.
