

 **SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE**

Many thanks to those who were able to welcome Deacon Kenny Uhlich and his family this past Sunday in the rectory! He wishes to express his gratitude for your many words of kindness. We sincerely look forward to his service to St. Patrick's. I'm grateful also to those who assisted with making the reception a great success.

For centuries, the faithful throughout Europe have been erecting wayside crucifixes (also known as Calvary shrines) as signs of faith for passers-by. Some were placed to invoke God's protection on cities, others provided safety in dangerous areas of travel and others were markers of gratitude that an affliction had passed. For whatever the cause, these public displays of faith serve as visible reminders of God's presence and His action in our midst. Inspired by this tradition, I dreamt of installing such a crucifix here at St. Patrick's. Much quicker than I expected, the Lord provided the means necessary to carry out the project, thanks to the skills and generosity of our parishioners!

While our new Calvary shrine is European in inspiration, the execution was uniquely New Orleanian. The old-world styling of cast iron ornamentation and copper roof evoke our local context while adding nobility and beauty to the piece. The wood of the cross is another piece of "old New Orleans." It is a beam of reclaimed old-growth cypress. It was refinished and recrafted by a parishioner into its current form. The corpus is made of cast iron as well, and probably of European provenance. It was acquired from a collector on the Northshore and repainted by a devout Catholic liturgical artist living with his young family in Folsom.

This project could not have been possible without the help of many who volunteered their time and skills. The men of our St. Joseph's Guild were instrumental in completing this project. Thanks to our dedicated volunteer gardener, the image is honored with beautiful flowers. Let us also be sure to pray for the repose of Mr. John Schroder, Jr., in whose memory much needed funds were donated for our new shrine.

It is my hope that all those who see this beautiful representation of our Lord's love for us would be drawn to a moment of prayer and to a deeper faith! ~ Fr. O'Brien
