 **SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE**

Before the hurricane, I was sharing with our parishioners the various reflections of the faithful of St. Patrick's regarding the reasons the traditional Latin Mass was important to them. I'd like to conclude this series by sharing the thoughts of a woman who writes eloquently about the spiritual value she finds in the Latin Mass, as well as the complementarity she sees in the Novus Ordo Mass in English. We live at a very unique time in the Church where the two expressions of the Roman Rite exist, and our duty is to foster sincere unity with all of our brothers and sisters who share in the Heavenly Feast of the Most Blessed Sacrament.

"I am a convert to Catholicism. When I converted at 17 years old it was against the express wishes of my parents who were anti-Catholic to say the least. All I knew of Catholicism was the Novus Ordo mass. I was fortunate that, in Ohio at the time, my priest was an incredible spiritual leader to the extremely small community of Catholics. I fell in love with Catholicism because of the Novus Ordo mass."

She continues that after marrying, her husband asked her to attend the Latin Mass with him. She writes, "Although I felt lost at first, unsure about what to do, my husband reassured me that "all the masses are the same where it matters." He was right. Even though, at first, I didn't understand what was being said, I knew the mass because the mass is so similar, and is the same where it matters, as all other rites in the church. After several months I began to understand the mass and appreciate the experience and how it transported my mind spiritually to ancient and holy places."

As she continued, she shared with me some of the ways that the Lord concretely used the Latin Mass to draw her deeper into her faith. "I was a faithful Catholic before, but I don't think I ever had the desire to entirely devote my life to Jesus. I knew the Roman Catholic Church was the one true church and that I wanted to be there, but that is as far as I ever considered. I never really contemplated the true presence of Christ in the Eucharist. I was always distracted at mass, always making lists in my head of things I needed to do. The Traditional Latin Mass being in a different language from the vernacular, having the extra ceremony with the incense, the organ music, the priest facing the tabernacle and having all eyes on Jesus, that transports me. I feel that I need the mass to not be in English. I need that other-ness that the Latin creates. As I mentioned above, I feel transported to ancient, holy, places when I go to mass and all my thoughts, stresses, and musings of life outside of the church in the world melt away. It is just my Savior and I in an intimate communication for that time."

While these graces are a special gift to her, she continues to remember the blessings she received when the Novus Ordo was all she knew. Because of this, she understands well the importance of supporting others who find spiritual nourishment in other expressions of the Mass. She concludes, "All forms of the mass connect to different people for different reasons. I loved that the Roman Catholic Church allowed for several different forms so that all people could feel that deep connection to God in the way that I do in the Traditional Latin Mass."
