**FAMILY FUNDAMENTALS**

"To pray the Rosary *for children*, and even more, *with children*, training them from their earliest years to experience this daily "pause for prayer" with the family, is admittedly not the solution to every problem, but it is a spiritual aid which should not be underestimated. It could be objected that the Rosary seems hardly suited to the taste of children and young people of today. But perhaps the objection is directed to an impoverished method of praying it. Furthermore, without prejudice to the Rosary's basic structure, there is nothing to stop children and young people from praying it – either within the family or in groups – with appropriate symbolic and practical aids to understanding and appreciation."



In a reflective continuation on St. John Paul II's apostolic letter, *Rosarium Virginis Mariae*, St. John Paul II expands on the rosary and its relationship to the family, specifically children. There is a deep juxtaposition between the rote recitation and the deep contemplation simultaneously involved. This unique contrast does allow the rosary to be accessible to *all*. Our Lady opens wide her arms for us through her most blessed rosary! From small children to mature adults, the faithful recitation of this sacramental promises to bear deep supernatural fruits that always lead to Our Lord.

## SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

At this time of year, the Church directs our minds to the Last Things: death, judgement, Heaven and Hell. The Feast of Christ the King reminds us that our Savior is the Lord over all the Earth. The proximity of the celebrations of All Saints Day and All Souls Day give us the chance to honor the Lord's dominion over Heaven and Purgatory as well. As our liturgical year comes to a close, the month of November is our time to pray especially for our beloved dead. This long standing tradition is mentioned in the Catechism, "From the beginning the Church has honored the memory of the dead and offered prayers in suffrage for them, above all the Eucharistic Sacrifice, so that, thus purified, they may be able to attain the beatific vision of God. The Church also commends almsgiving, indulgences, and works of penance undertaken on behalf the dead." (CCC 1032).

Please take a moment to submit the names of your departed loved ones for entry into our parish **Book of the Dead**. These individuals will be prayed for during the month of November. Several Masses have been set aside just for that very intention. Feel free to submit names to the parish office, to use the envelopes in the rear of Church or to write the names in our book which will be on display at the Masses on All Souls Day.

Of course, prayer for the living and the dead is a spiritual work of mercy at any time of year. Having Masses offered for the living or the dead is an important practice of devotion that helps us to act on our conviction regarding the power of the Mass. When someone has a Mass offered for their intention, the prayer of the priest is especially focused on that intention, and the Mass calls upon God's grace in the most effective way we know. For, when our Father looks upon our offering of the Mass, He sees the perfect offering of love rendered to Him by His Son. About the practice of sponsoring Mass intentions, Pope Paul VI wrote in the *Motu Proprio, Firma in Traditione* that "the faithful, desiring in a religious and ecclesial spirit to participate more in intimately in the Eucharistic sacrifice, add to it a form of sacrifice of their own by which they contribute in a particular way to the needs of the Church and especially to the sustenance of her ministers."

Particularly, in this coming month of intercession for the dead, please consider contacting our parish office to learn more about Mass intentions. Other pious practices are available to pray for and honor your loved ones. These include our bulletin's "In Memory Of" list, or dedicating candles at our altars and shrines to a particular intention. By these pious acts, we carry out a loving work of prayer, and we render to God a public act of gratitude for His graces and blessings.

I would like to bring your attention to this year's iGiveCatholic fundraising campaign. Last year, your generosity enabled us to complete two significant art projects for our parish and acquire some furniture for Holy Week liturgies. This year, our focus is more outward. I'm very glad to report that our parishioners are constantly looking for opportunities to grow in their faith. Whether by children's choir, adult book studies, Sacramental preparation, or young adult social events, St. Patrick's is seeking edify the faithful. I am requesting for you to prayerfully consider donating to further these efforts this year. Another outreach effort worthy of your consideration is our "Blessing Bags" campaign. We all know how frequently we encounter the needy on the streets. A Blessing Bag is a small package you keep in your car to distribute to those in need. This year, we will be collecting items and assembling these bags for distribution to parishioners on *Gaudete* Sunday. The following items can be dropped off in the rectory: gallon Ziploc bags, water bottles, granola bars, cheese crackers, new socks, small bottles of hand sanitizer, individual packs of tissues. We have all experienced God's blessings come to us through St. Patrick's and St. John the Baptist Churches. 


