SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

These last two weeks, I was blessed to spend some time away for vacation and retreat. Please know that you all were with me in spirit! I prayed for all our parishioners frequently with the monks at Our Lady of Clear Creek Abbey in Oklahoma. My sincere gratitude to Fr. Luke Melcher for serving the parish during my time out.

Please stop by the St. Jude statue in the narthex to notice a newly created candle stand there. A talented parishioner crafted the piece by hand and donated it for the glory of God. May God reward you!



Despite the brief hiatus, please allow me to conclude my reflections on the writings of St. John Chrysostom on the Eucharist. Recall that he is a church father writing in Constantinople in the late 4th century. St. John expounds upon the theme of our need to be worthy to partake in the Eucharist saying, "Take care, then, lest you too become guilty of the Body and Blood of Christ [1 Cor 11:27]. [...] How very pure, then, ought he not be, who enjoys the benefit of this sacrifice?"

Regarding the power of the Eucharistic sacrifice for the dead, St. John writes, "Not in vain was it decreed by the apostles that in the awesome Mysteries, remembrance should be made of the departed. They knew that here, there was much gain for them, much benefit. For when the entire people stands with hands uplifted, a priestly assembly, and that awesome sacrificial victim is laid out, how, when we are calling upon God, should we not succeed in their defense? But this is done for those who have departed in the faith [...]"

Lastly, I love how St. John connects the ideas of Eucharist sacrifice with Eucharistic communion. The holy Mass is a sacrifice which brings about our unity with God as well as our unity with the other members of the Body of Christ. "[...] Now He has transferred the priestly action [of ancient times] to what is most awesome and magnificent. He has changed the sacrifice itself, and instead of the butchering of dumb beasts, He commands the offering up of Himself....What is that Bread? The Body of Christ! What do they become who are partakers therein? The Body of Christ! Not many bodies, but one Body." ~Fr. O'Brien
