There to Thee our Alleluia Singing everlastingly.

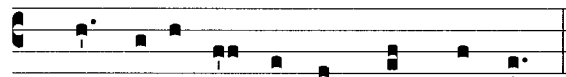

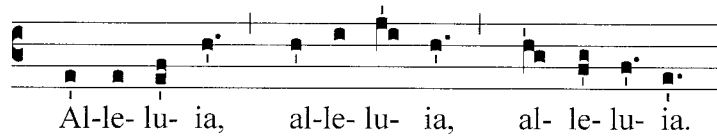
