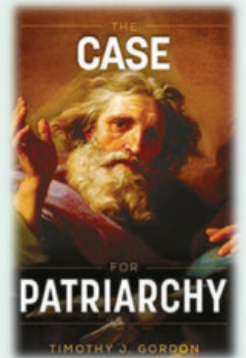
Catholic Author Timothy Gordon
