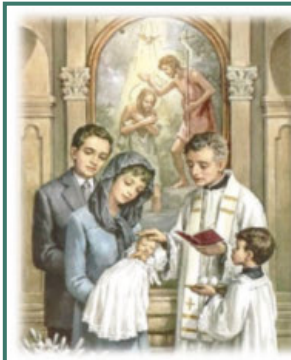
INTERESTED IN BECOMING CATHOLIC?

SEMINARIAN SPOTLIGHT DANILE MICHAH

I am a diocesan seminarian for the Archdiocese of Tororo in Uganda undertaking formation at Notre Dame Seminary in New Orleans.

I was born in the town of Sipi- Kapchorwa and raised in a Catholic family of seven. My early life set me on my journey to the priesthood in various ways. My family enjoyed frequent visits by priests especially at a time when my mother was ill for a couple of years. These priests prayed, cooked and took care of us with love as my dad struggled to sustain the family amidst such difficult times.

When my mother's condition became much worse, our pastor asked my dad if he would accept the sacrament of holy matrimony. This met resistance from many relatives who thought there was no reason to wed a dying woman. My Dad, however, was moved by faith, stood firm and received the sacrament with only five people in attendance; my parents, two witnesses and the priest, which is unheard of in a typical African community. Miraculously, after the sacrament of marriage was performed, my mother began to recover and lives to this day. Since then my parents have been an inspiration to many couples in our parish.

As I travelled to the various seminaries in Uganda, I came across many street children and something within me kept saying "if you can only be a priest and have daily mass for these suffering children they may be helped."

Finally, my hometown has very few vocations compared to other towns in the Archdiocese. I felt a great need to take on this yoke of vocation to the priesthood so that I could minister to God's children knowing that with Christ as my model, the yoke will be easy and the burden light.

I began my formation from high school at St Pius X of Nagongera Seminary for six years and then major Seminary at Uganda Martyrs' National Major Seminary for three years and now at Notre Dame for graduate theological studies.
