

SHOUT YOUR ADOPTION

Several months ago, a young couple was married here at St. Patrick Church. David Scotton, the handsome groom was much like the scores of grooms who nervously await their beautiful brides at the foot of our magnificent altar, with one distinction. Many years before the wedding, David's life came perilously close to ending before it had barely begun in a faraway abortion clinic.

I Lived on Parker Avenue is an inspirational documentary that tells David's powerful story and the impact one decision can make. In David's words, "My biological mother is a hero...her decision to leave the abortion clinic and choose the adoption gave me the gift of life, gave my parents the gift of their only son and gave my grandparents the gift of their only grandchild."

The documentary is available to see free of charge on YouTube and has been viewed by hundreds of thousands since its debut in 2018. One person who watched the 30-minute video and was captivated by its message was the actor Kirk Cameron. As a result, David's story will move to the big screen in September with a full-length, feature film entitled **Lifemark**.

In light of the recent overturning of Roe v Wade, the timing of this feature film and the renewed visibility it provides, the documentary could not have come at a better time. It is essential that adoption be seen for what it truly is, a brave, selfless, loving decision that not only saves one life, but continues to positively impact many, many more...like a beautiful bride, and every one of the joyful relatives and friends who gathered to celebrate a wedding that was only possible because of the great sacrifice made by a young, frightened woman many years ago.

SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

A few months ago, on my annual retreat, I was reflecting on the writings of St. Francis de Sales in a book called, <u>The Secret of Sanctity</u>. In it, Fr. Jean Crasset, SJ (d. 1692) compiles the writings of de Sales with some other commentators on Spiritual Theology. Today, I'd like to begins a series of excerpts and reflections on this work. I hope it will provide some benefit to you in your own spiritual life!

At the beginning of the spiritual life is a conviction that God is real and that He is knowable. He is knowable because, even though He is mysterious and beyond our comprehension, He nonetheless is orderly. Stemming from this notion, then, is the fact that our spiritual lives, too, are at their best when they are orderly as well. Reflect on this passage, "Order and virtue are almost synonymous terms. Order is the guide of virtue, and virtue is the guide of order. Whatever good you do, if you do it not in order, you do it not well. Reason requires sometimes that we depart from the order we have prescribed; only to follow, however, a more perfect order required by necessity, charity, infirmity, or obedience. Inclination is the guide of beasts; reason of man; the Gospels of Christians; the rule of religious; order of all creatures. Which will you choose? It is order that makes paradise, and disorder which makes hell."

These are the opening words of de Sales' exhortation to the development of one's own spiritual life. If our prayer lives are haphazard, why should we expect them to bear fruit that will sustain us? On the other hand, since order is the hallmark of God's Kingdom in Heaven, then the striving after an orderly spiritual discipline here in this life is nothing short of a striving after Heaven itself!

With this in mind, de Sales offers some self-examination: "Is your state one of order? ... Are you not guided by inclination or caprice? Is your will sufficiently upright to serve you as a rule or guide? If so, your sanctity equals that of God; for He alone can take His will as His guide. ... What merit would you have in doing only as you please?"

To gradually develop a heavenly order in our lives, we can make it our practice to insert more order even into the everyday things of life. We can first hold fast to a minimum of daily prayer, but also follow a routine for eating, socializing, work and leisure activity. All of these are vital human activities, and all can become spiritually enriched by greater orderliness.

De Sales wastes no time addressing the question of the inspirations of the Holy Spirit. While these may prompt us to depart from our self-imposed order, the Holy Spirit, the Spirit of order, will always urge us toward God's law and not toward human passions. "Happy he who abandons himself to the guidance of God and does nothing but by His orders." ~Fr. O'Brien


