SEMINARIAN SPOTLIGHT

My name is Seth Smith, and I am a seminarian at Notre Dame Seminary. I was born and raised in Destrehan, LA. My home parish is St. Charles Borromeo in Destrehan, and I went to school there as well from preschool to eighth grade. I went to Destrehan High School and graduated in the Class of 2019. After high school, I decided to go to LSU to become a physician assistant. I went to LSU for two years doing very well in school, but something was missing.



I was not happy and I knew I was not doing what I was supposed to be doing with my life. I returned to the faith, and after developing a consistent prayer life, the call to priesthood started to creep in. As I spent more and more time in deep prayer just asking God what He wanted from me and what He wanted me to do with my life, the call became more obvious.

I soon after applied to the Archdiocese of New Orleans Vocations Office and was accepted to start in the fall of 2021. I just finished my first year of priestly formation at Notre Dame Seminary and it was truly incredible. I spent this past summer at St. Joan of Arc in LaPlace for my eight week summer assignment, which was a very wonderful experience that continued to affirm my vocation. I am about to begin my second year of Pre-Theology in the fall of 2022, and I am very excited to continue on this long journey to priesthood!



SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

About one year ago, we blessed the new crucifix in front of St. Patrick's Church. Just last week, the final touches were added to the piece, namely, a wooden perch for our Lord's feet with Adam's skull displayed, and a newly-made "INRI" titulus. The titulus crucis is the name of the sacred relic that St. Helena brought to Rome from the Holy Land in the 4th century. The relic matches the biblical details of the inscription put on the Lord's cross by Pontius Pilate who wrote Jesus of Nazareth, King of the Jews in Latin, Greek and Hebrew. "INRI" represents the Latin version of the inscription, "Iesus Nazarenus Rex Iudeorum." The relic itself is displayed in the Basilica of Santa Croce in Gerusaleme in Rome. Paleographic analysis carried out on this relic in 1997 and found it to be consistent with other first century writing samples. The three languages of the titulus signify the proclamation of the Gospel to the whole world. In the Mass, these three languages are present still, yet another sign that at Mass, we are present at Calvary. Latin is the language of the Roman Rite; Greek is used at the "Kyrie;" and Hebrew is present in the "Alleluia," "Amen," and "Hosanna."



Three weeks ago I requested volunteers and nominations for St. Patrick's Pastoral Council. Thank you to those who responded. I would like to renew my request once again this week. The Pastoral Council has the role of assisting the pastor to be aware of and respond to the unique needs of our parishioners. Their advice is essential as decisions are made for future planning and promoting the effective sanctification of our community. The council assists to identify new volunteers and to organize initiatives which can reach out to our neighborhood and our city for the purpose of spreading the Gospel. It is composed of ex officio members, such as myself and our parish deacons, as well as appointed and, if possible, elected members. The needs of our parish are indeed unique. We provide for two functioning historic churches and serve parishioners from many different areas in both the English and Latin Mass. I hope that representatives, at least 7 members, from every aspect of our parish life will get involved.
